Proposed Action

Background

On October 7, 2024, the public comment period closed for the draft Imagine 2050 plan, the Met Council's regional development guide. Imagine 2050 includes each of the Met Council's system and policy plans, including regional parks and trails, transportation, water resources, land use, and housing.

At the November 18, 2024, Community Development Committee (CDC) meeting, Council staff will share a summary of the public comments that focus on the Land Use Policy Chapter and outline next steps. While the focus of the November CDC meeting will be on public comments received during this specific period, it is important to remember that the Met Council has been engaging residents, community organizations, young leaders, agency partners, local governments, and Met Council members across the region for several years. The 90% draft plan for public comment is a culmination of those efforts and combined contributions of the people in the region.

Comments on the draft policy plan were received from agencies, local governmental units, and the public. Many commenters provided feedback via an online platform implemented by the Met Council specifically for the Imagine 2050 public comment period. Others provided comments via email/mail, during the public hearing, or at one of over 20 Art + Policy engagement events.

Given the variety of engagement opportunities at multiple scales, comments ranged from very broad (e.g., responding to the prompt, "what are your dreams for the region?") to highly specific (e.g., commenting on a draft action within the policy plan). Broad comments primarily came from the public and those attending Art + Policy engagement events. Specific comments came from local government partners. At the November 18, 2024, CDC meeting, Council staff will share key themes emerging from the public comment process, identify areas of support and areas of concern, and seek guidance on policy direction.

On January 21, 2025, Council staff will share a draft final policy plan and public comment report for the Committee's consideration. Imagine 2050 is proposed for adoption by the Metropolitan Council on February 12, 2025 (Table 1).

The draft policy plan is the result of numerous discussions with regional partners, the Land Use Advisory Committee (LUAC), CDC, the Council Member RDG Work Group (RDG WG), Met Council's Committee of the Whole (COW), as well as extensive outreach to residents, prioritized communities, community organizations, and local governments. Engagement on draft land use policy and density began in July 2023 following development of preliminary regional vision, values, and goals, as well as critical informative analysis on Community Designations and Scenario Planning. This work was also done with intentional collaboration with the policy teams from housing, parks, water, and transportation. A summary of this engagement appears in Table 2 below.
