

- Over 7,200 households served
- Anoka and Carver County;
 Suburban Hennepin & Ramsey
 County
 - 96 Communities
- 2024: \$90 million in housing assistance payment

- Submitted every 5th year
- Currently approved 2025 2029

Metro HRA Administrative Plan Revisions


Annual Plan

- Submitted annually to HUD in October
- Approved for 2025

PURPOSE

- Provide strategies for meeting identified housing goals and needs in the coming year.
- Communicate elements of the plan that have been updated or revised.

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Mandatory Updates: HOTMA

PRE-HOTMA

- Defined inclusions and exclusions
- Income projections were used based on current information provided; restricted use of some verifications

HOTMA

- Included unless explicitly excluded
- Expanded authority to project income



 Required implementation date: October 1, 2025

 Streamlined inspection standards across federal programs



Mandatory Updates: NSPIRE

Example #1

Smoke Alarms

PRE-NSPIRE

Required installation on each level including basements

NSPIRE

Required installation on each level and inside each sleeping area

Example #2

Dryer Vents

PRE-NSPIRE

 24-hour failed inspections for missing, damaged, or visually inoperable gas dryer vents

HOTMA

 24-hour failed inspections for missing, damaged, or visually inoperable gas and electric dryer vents
