




## Regional Parks System Plan Map



- Washington County match: \$433,561






## Metropolitan Council

### Rationale for recommendation

#### **Consistent with:**

- The Parks and Trails Legacy Fund and the Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund
- The Big Marine Park Reserve long-range plan;
- Washington County is within it's \$1.7
  million per fiscal year limit for the PTLF
  and ENRTF Park Acquisition Opportunity
  Funds.

### Recommendations

### That the Metropolitan Council:

- 1. Approve a grant of up to \$1,300,682 from the Park Acquisition Opportunity Fund to Washington County to acquire an 80-acre parcel located in the southeast quadrant of 180<sup>th</sup> Street and Manning Trail in Marine-on-St. Croix, MN, for the Big Marine Park Reserve.
- 2. Authorize the Community Development Director to execute the grant agreement and restrictive covenant on behalf of the Council.
