

# **PRO Housing**

#### **Regular updates to CDC as programs launch**

**\$9M HUD-funded effort to shift the policy and development environment to meet the region's housing needs, with work continuing through 2030** 

- Partnership with Hennepin and Ramsey Counties
- Improve policy & support planning through peer learning and technical assistance
- Direct grants to implement local policy and programs
- Build new deeply affordable housing for households living on 30% of the Area Median Income (\$37,250) or less


#### What we do

- Competitive grants to cities, counties and development authorities
- Incentivizes and supports cities • implementing regional policy goals
- Cities must adopt housing goals to participate

#### **Program goals**

- Equitable development outcomes
