#### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council adopt the Facility Plan for Seneca Area System Rehabilitation Phases 3, 4 and 5, MCES Project Nos. 808030, 808040, and 808050 per the attached Resolution No. 2014-2.

#### Background

The Facility Plan addresses interceptor improvements for the 3-BV-39 Interceptor located in the City of Burnsville. The proposed improvements will restore the integrity of MCES facilities; minimize wastewater spill potential that could pose a threat to the environment, other community assets, public safety, and health; and improve system reliability. The recommended improvements will occur in phases over the next 5 years and will include:

- Phase 3 Replace 8,982 lineal feet of gravity interceptor and rehabilitate associated MH structures.
- Phase 4 Replace 8,190 lineal feet of gravity interceptor and rehabilitate associated MH structures.
- Phase 5 Line 15,326 lineal feet of gravity interceptor and rehabilitate associated MH structures.

A Public Hearing was held on January 30<sup>th</sup>. The hearing was attended by four residents. No significant comments were received at the public hearing. If significant issues arise during the comment period ending February 10, staff will present them at the committee meeting.

#### Rationale

Public Facilities Authority (PFA) loan funding eligibility requires formal adoption of the Facility Plan by resolution (attached), following a public hearing on the draft Facility Plan.

#### Funding

Project cost estimates are consistent with the Capital Program. Funds for the planning, design, and construction are included in the 2014 Capital Program. MCES will submit this project to PFA for inclusion in its 2015 Intended Use Plan.
