### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the 1-MN-344 Interceptor Rehabilitation, MCES Project Number 807628, Contract No. 13P228, with Lametti & Sons, Inc. for their low responsive, responsible bid of \$6,141,700.00.

### Background

The work is located in south Minneapolis and involves cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining of 12,000 lineal feet of Interceptor 1-MN-344. The work involves pipe diameters of 9-inches to 40-inches. The contract also includes maintenance structure rehabilitation using a cured-in-place lining process. Three bids, ranging from \$6,141,700 to \$7,829,439, were received and opened on January 30, 2014. The engineer's estimate is \$11,549,534. Lametti & Sons, Inc. is the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

The project is funded by PFA loan and has disadvantaged business participation goals of 5% Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and 5% Women's Business Enterprise (WBE).

The Office of Equal Opportunity has determined that Lametti & Sons, Inc. has met the WBE goal and has made a good faith effort to achieve the MBE goal for this contract.

### Rationale

Construction contract awards exceeding \$2,500,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

### Funding

Project No. 807628 is included in the 2014 MCES Authorized Capital Program.

Requested Amount: \$6,141,700
