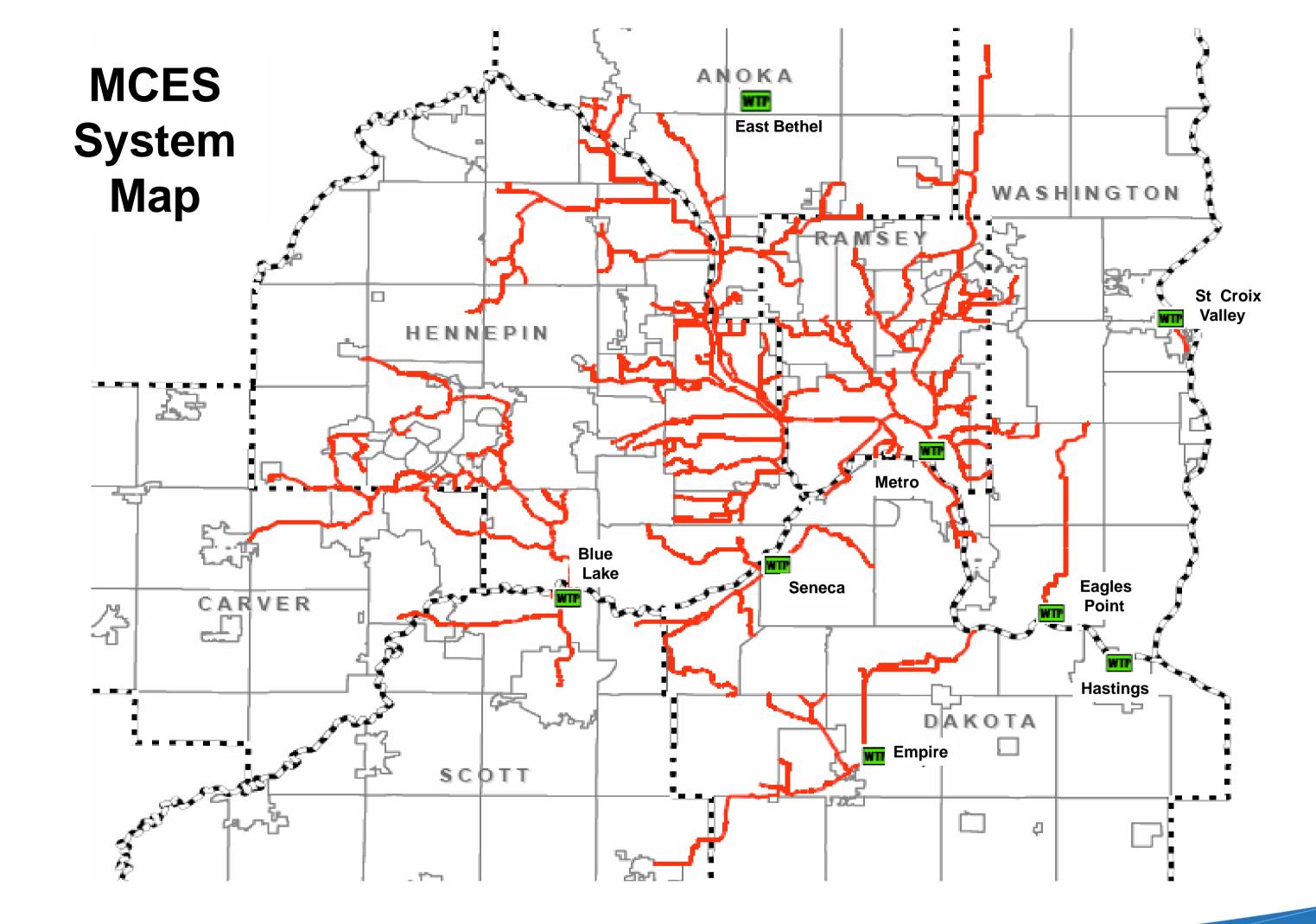

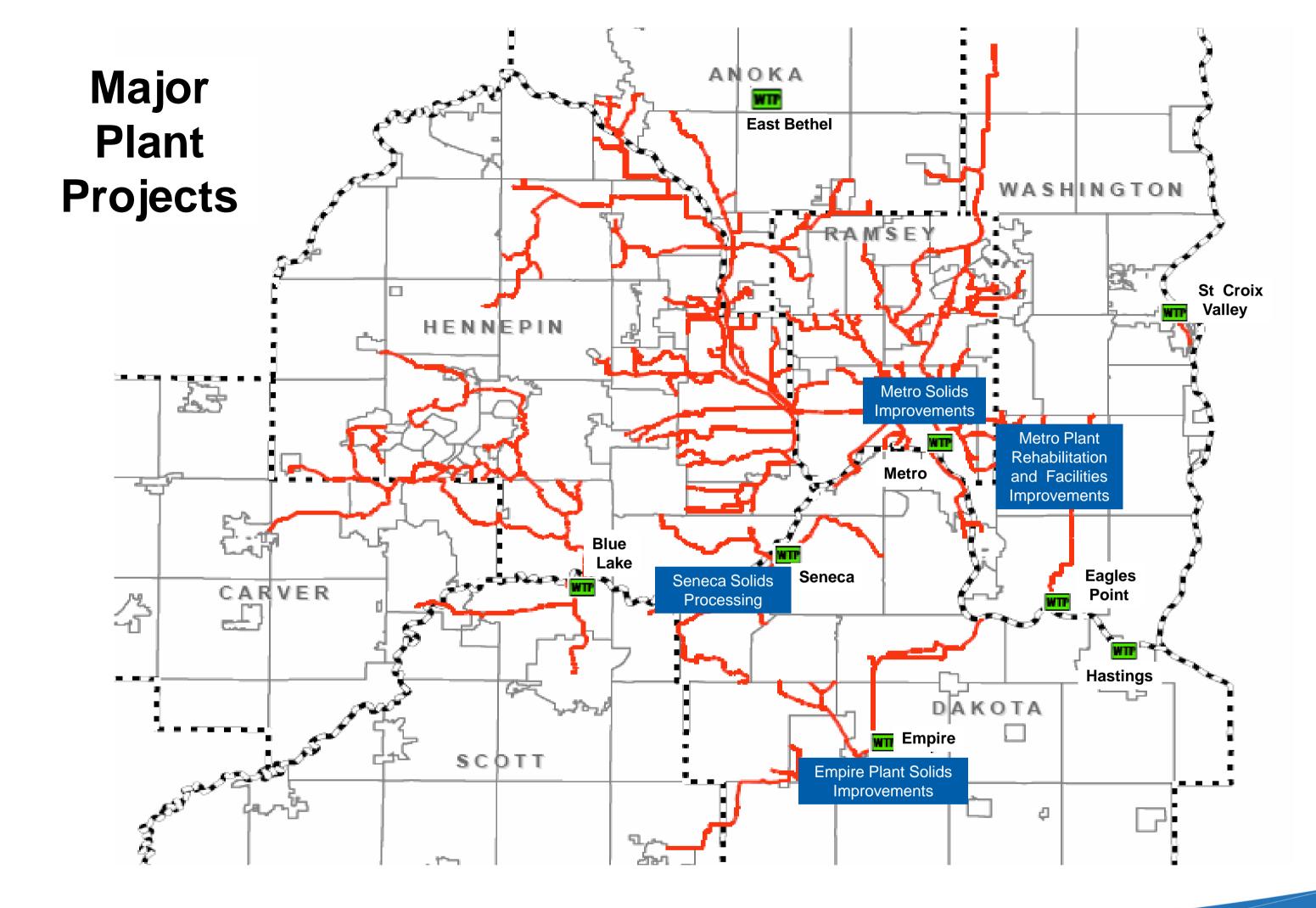

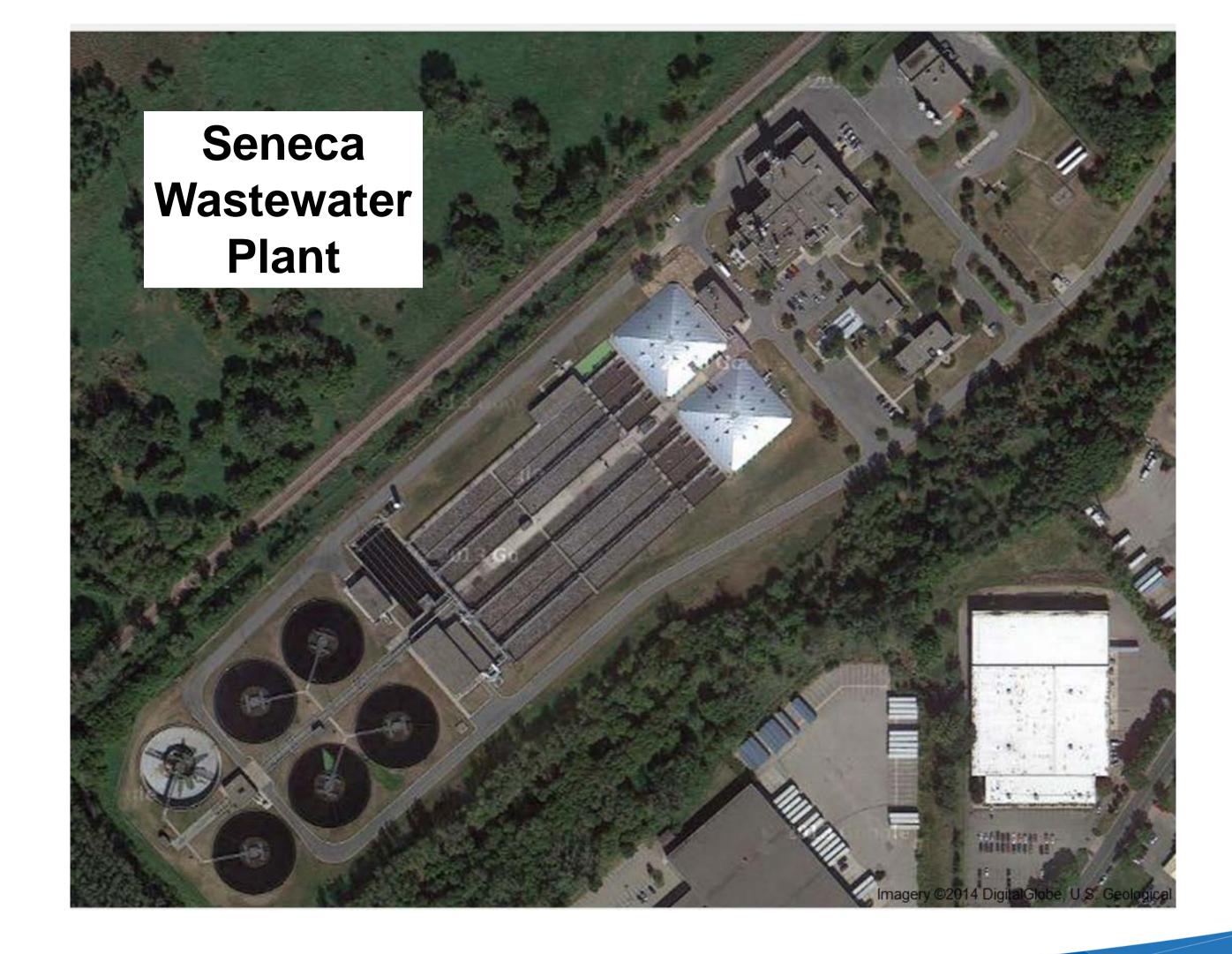
















# Quality

- Focus on reliability and energy conservation

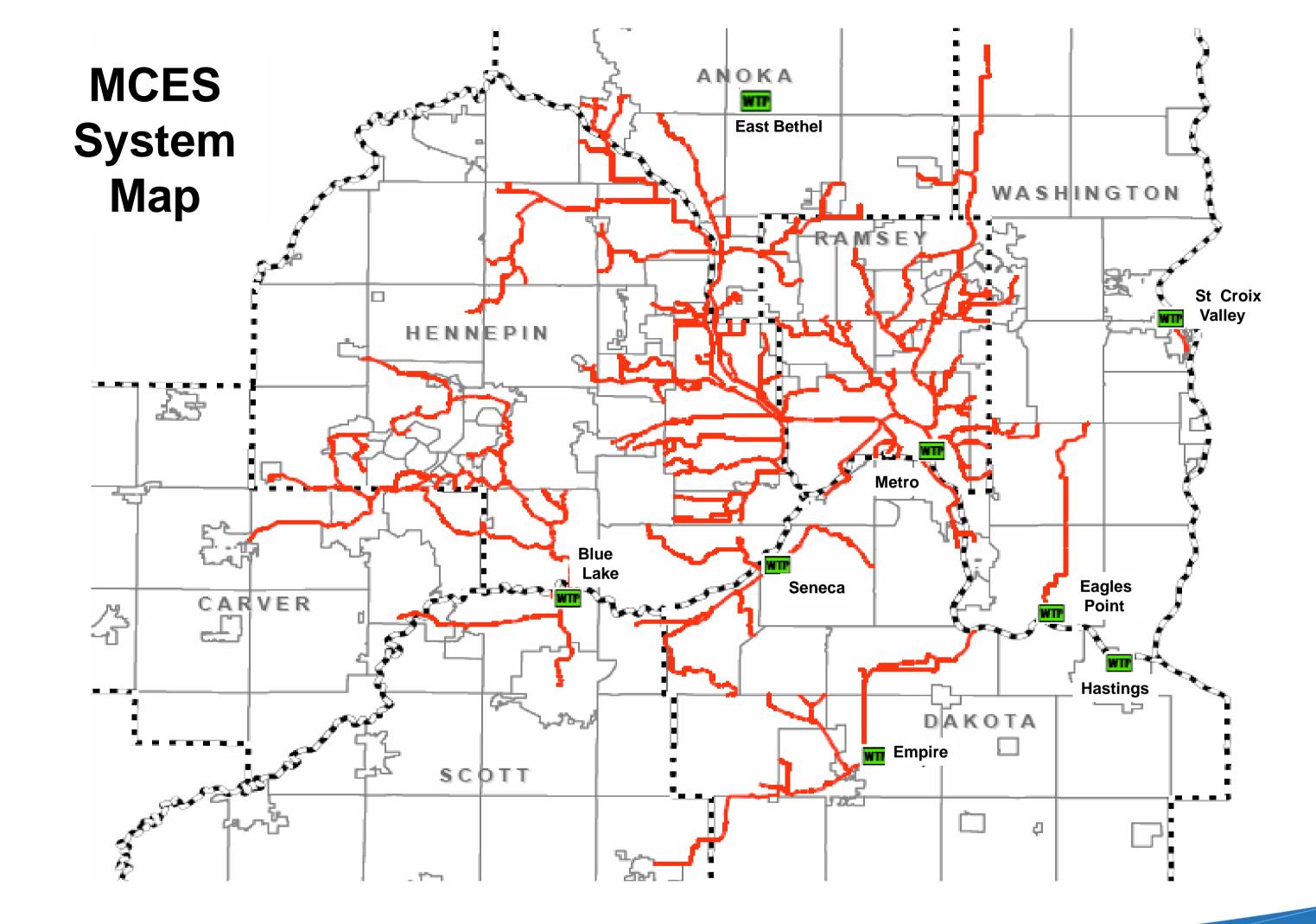
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# Interceptor System Components

- 9 combined sewer overflow regulators









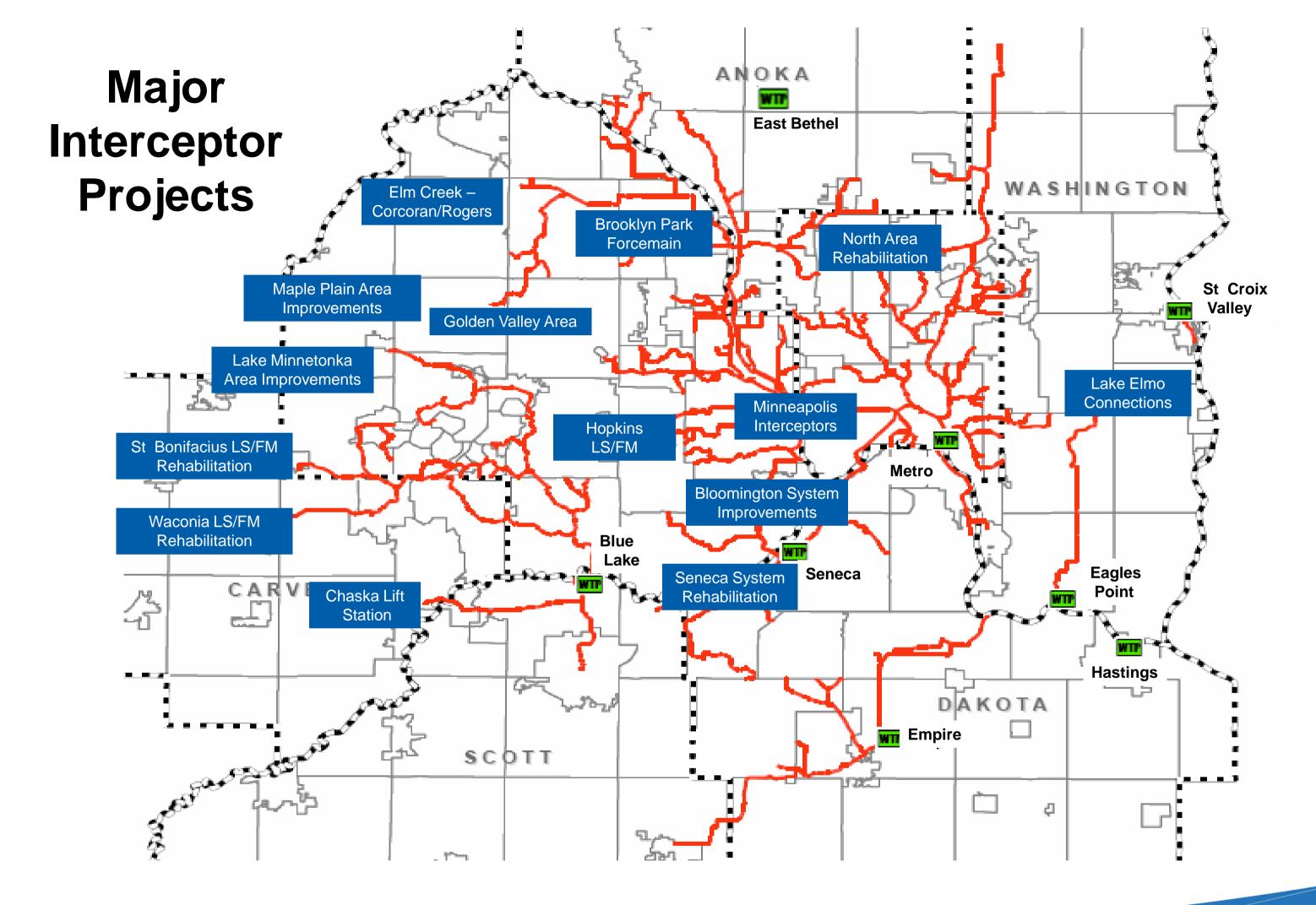

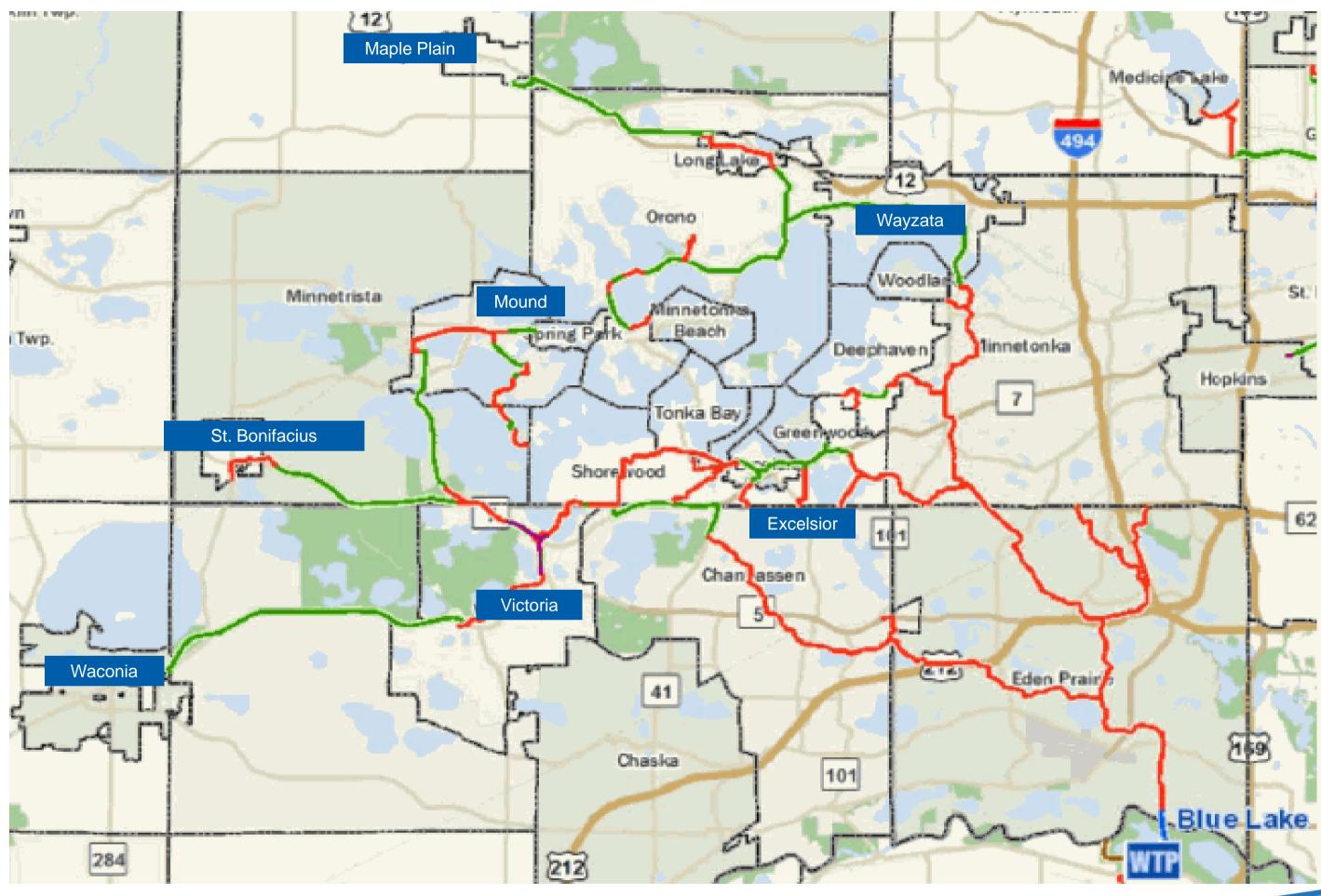

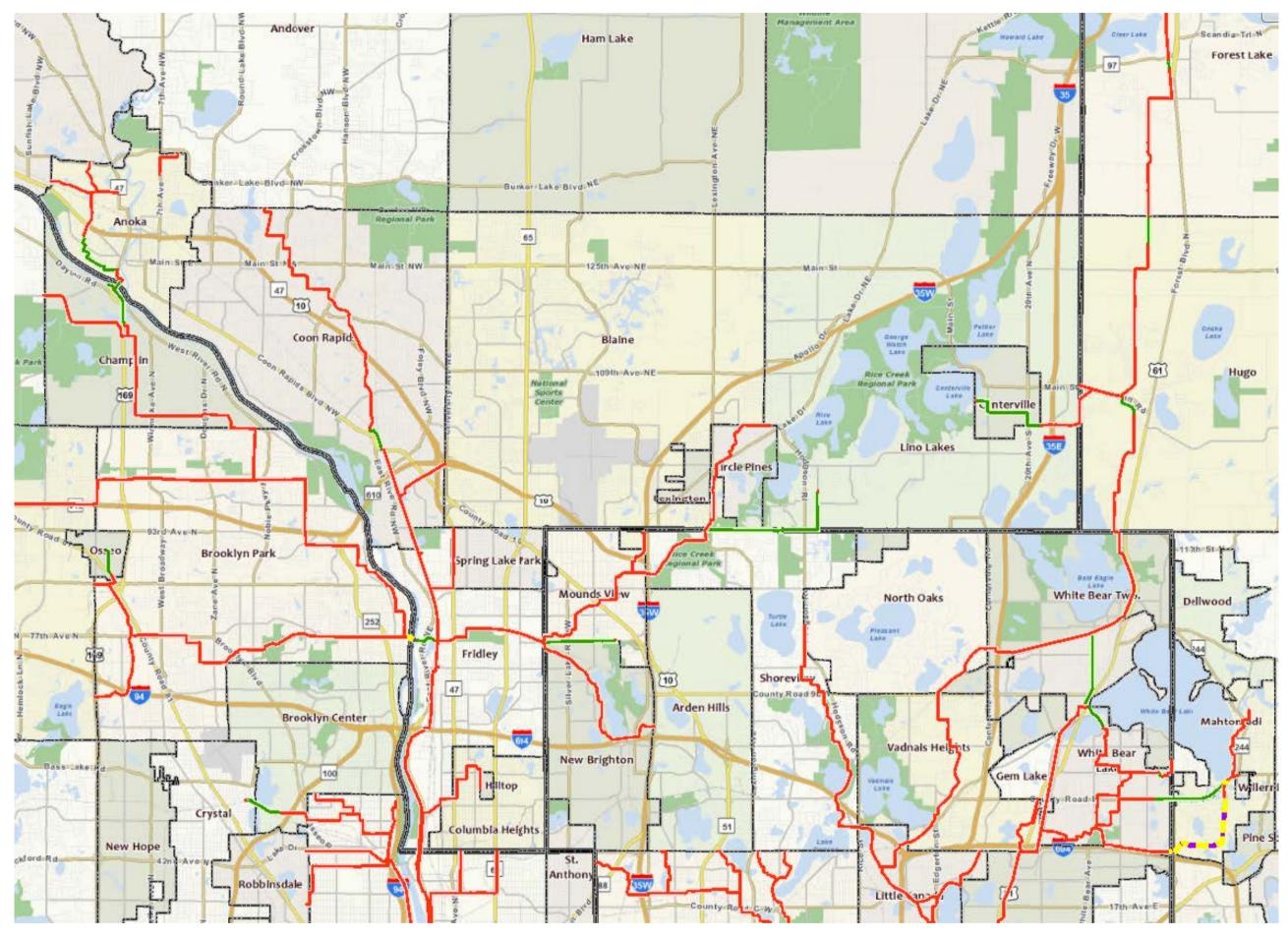

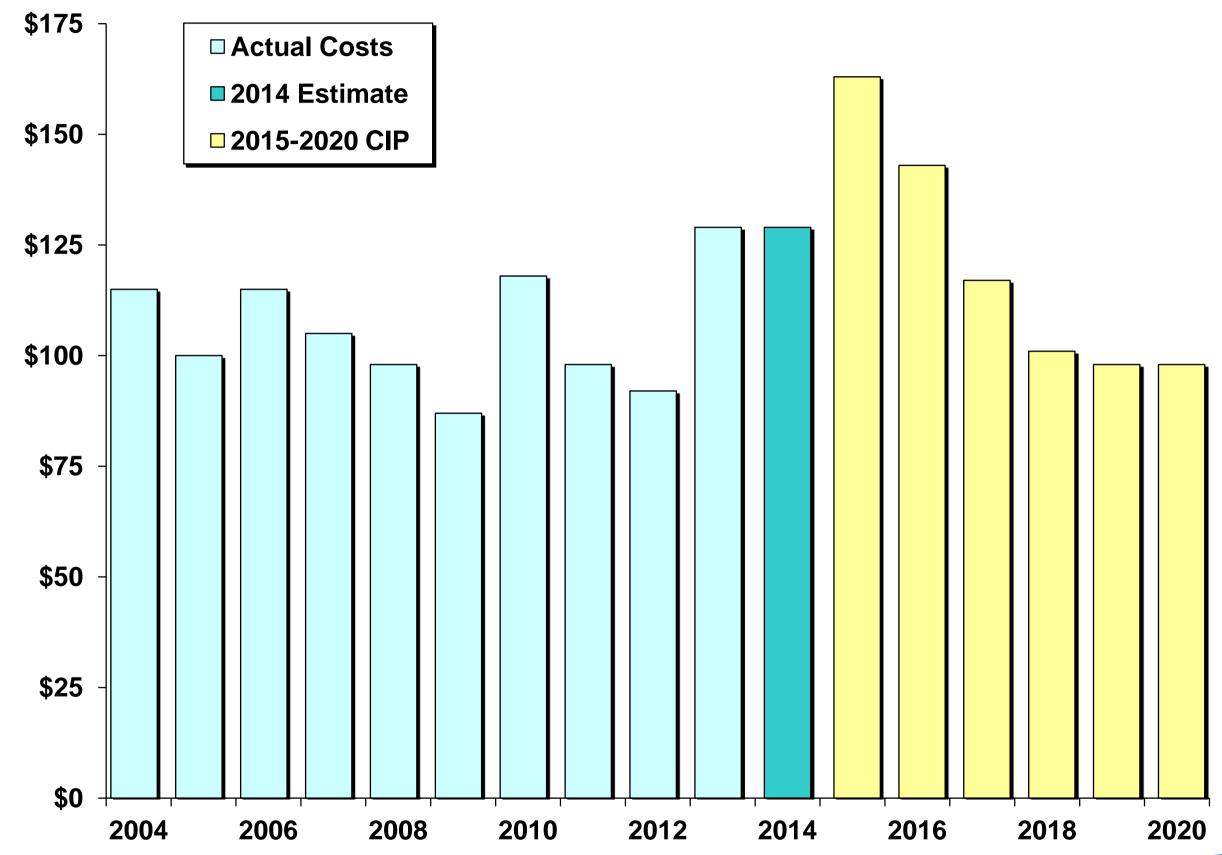

### **Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Expenditures by Year (\$ Millions)**

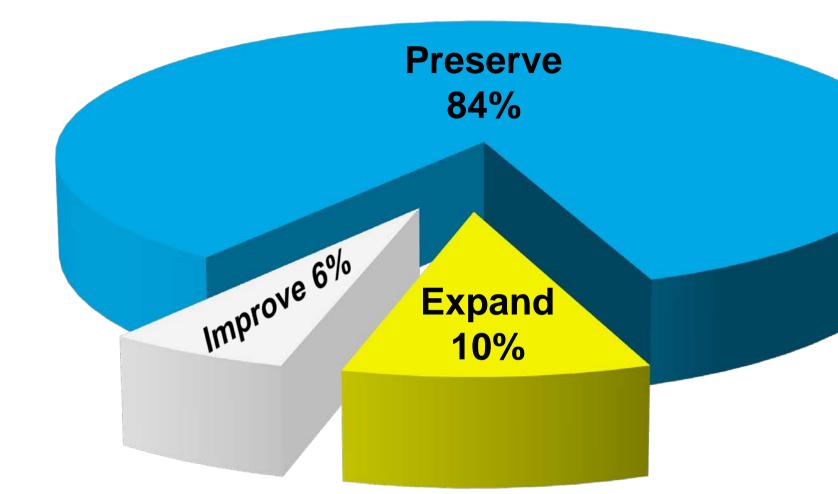








### **Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Cost Breakdown by Project Objective**



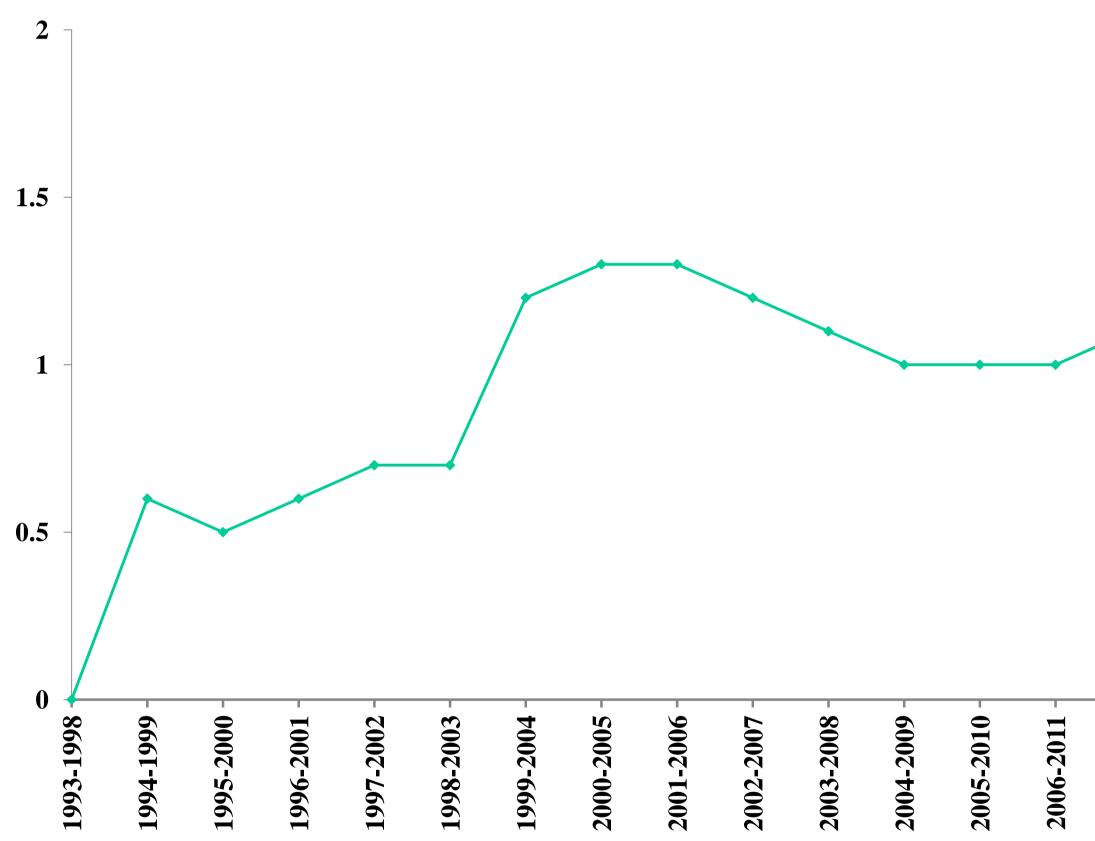

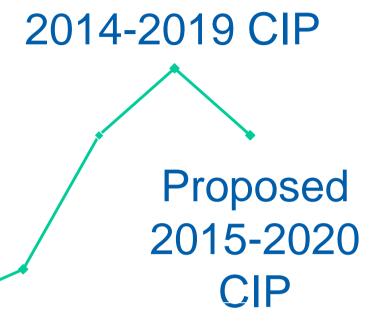


### **Asset Preservation Index (%) Six-Year Moving Average**



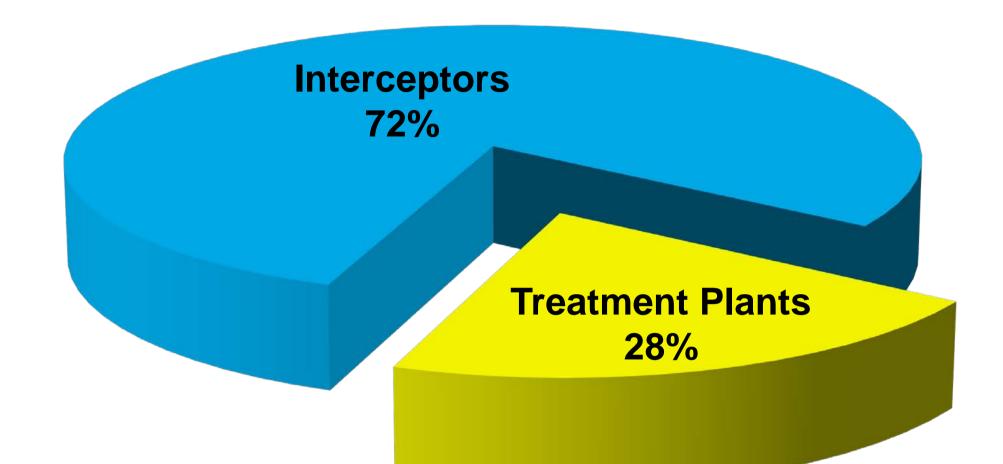








### **Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Cost Breakdown by Project Type**

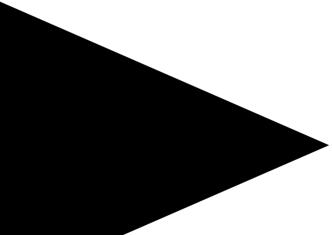






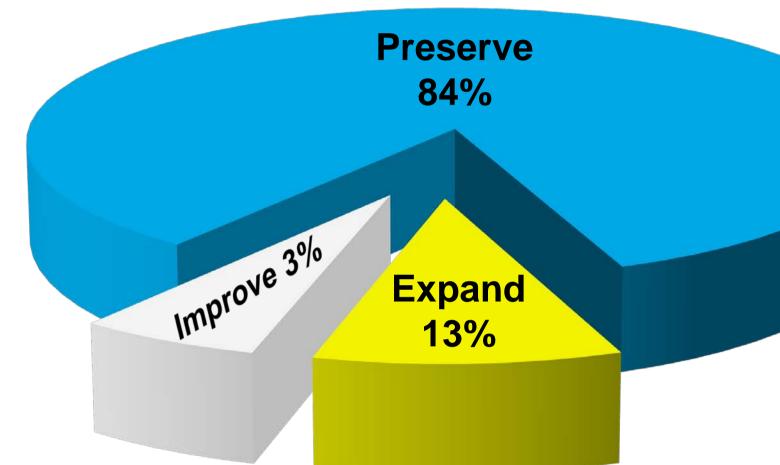


#### 2016 - 2020 **Proposed** (Net)
