Subject: Authorization to Negotiate and Execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) for Inclusion of Waconia Force Main Interceptor Improvements in Conjunction with MnDOT TH 5 Improvements Project

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a cooperative agreement with MnDOT for construction of Waconia Force Main interceptor improvements in conjunction with the MnDOT TH 5 Improvements Project.

Background

The MCES Waconia Interceptor system is a five-mile long dual force main consisting of a 14-inch cast iron pipe installed in 1975 and a 16-inch PVC pipe installed in 1998. The force main is located within MnDOT State Trunk Highway 5 right-of-way, beginning in Waconia and discharging in Victoria.

The 14-inch pipe is operating at capacity and is near the end of its service life.

In 2015, MnDOT is planning to temporarily close and resurface 3.5 miles of Highway 5 between Victoria Drive and Scandia Road. This presents an opportunity to replace 3.5 miles of the 14-inch pipe with a new force main pipe as part of MnDOT's project.

A cooperative project will extend the benefits of the temporary highway closure to the MCES project; will cause less traffic disruption than if the two projects were constructed separately.

Rationale

Cooperative agreements exceeding \$500,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

Funding

Funding is provided in the 2015 MCES Capital Budget, Project Number 808300.

The MCES cooperative agreement cost is estimated at \$6,600,000.
