### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the Chaska L71 Lift Station Replacement, Project No. 803920, Contract 14P134, with Magney Construction, Inc for their low responsive and responsible bid of \$10,875,600.

### Background

Lift Station improvements are required to improve the capacity of the Chaska Lift Station L71. Projected development within the cities of Chaska and Carver will cause wastewater flow to exceed the present lift station capacity.

The project will increase the capacity of the existing lift station from 9.7 MGD to 13 MGD, to provide capacity for future growth. Construction will also include the demolition of the existing lift station facilities, upon completion of the replacement lift station.

Four (4) bids, ranging from \$10,875,600 to \$16,187,000, were received and opened on December 2, 2014. The low bid was less than the engineer's estimate of \$10,973,925. The MCUB participation goal for this contract is 12%. The Office of Equal Opportunity has determined that Magney Construction, Inc. has met the numeric goals for this contract.

### Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$2,500,000 require Council authorization.

### Funding

Project No. 803920 is included in the 2015 MCES Authorized Capital Program.
