Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Mound for the construction of portions of city facilities within the Metropolitan Council Interceptor 6-MO-651 Improvement project.

Background

The Mound Interceptor Improvement project will construct a new L39 Lift Station, replace L40 Lift Station with a gravity pipe system, and construct a dual 10-inch sanitary sewer forcemain pipes. Project extents are from Brighton Commons to just north of the Wilshire Boulevard and Lakewood Lane intersection.

The City of Mound plans to upgrade their watermain system as part of the Metropolitan Council Project at an estimated City cost of \$1,200,000. The inconvenience to the residents along the route will be minimized by constructing these facilities within the same project.

This will be constructed under the proposed intergovernmental agreement with the City of Mound. This project is scheduled for construction during 2016-2017 with an estimated Metropolitan Council cost of \$13,800,000.

Rationale

Intergovernmental Agreements with a City exceeding \$500,000 requires Metropolitan Council authorization.
