Council Role in Water Supply Planning


2005 MN Statutes, Sec. 473.1565 - "Carry out planning" activities addressing the water supply needs of the metropolitan area"

- Development and maintenance of technical information;
- Development and periodic update of a metropolitan area master water supply plan,
- Clarifying the roles and responsibilities of local, regional, and state government in metropolitan area water supply;
- Streamlining and consolidating metropolitan area water supply decision-making and approval processes; and
- Funding of metropolitan area water supply planning activities and capital investments.





Metropolitan Water Planning Process




