MCES Pretreatment Program Functions

- Issue/administer Industrial Discharge Permits for industrial customers
- Conduct inspections/wastewater monitoring projects to check compliance/strength levels
- Take enforcement actions when violations occur
- Respond to treatment plant/sanitary sewer system problems caused by improper discharge



Additional MCES Pretreatment Program Functions

- Administer charges for high strength industrial wastewater, based on TSS/COD
- Hauled Waste Program for septic tank sludge/other trucked wastewater
- Program to accept landfill leachate/contaminated groundwater from cleanup sites
- Pollution Prevention and source reduction
- Mercury source evaluation and reduction
- Investigate emerging pollutants/new industrial customers

- 104 Special Discharge Permits
- 102 General Permits
 - Water supply plants
