Background

- MCES regularly convenes customer group to examine and evaluate SAC issues
- 2016 House and Senate bills introduced to exclude outdoor seating from SAC charges (did not pass)
- MCES and Metro Cities committed to convene a task force
- Task Force was opportunity to look at a few other outstanding issues
- Task Force authorized by Council on November 30, 2016

Issue 1: Review Current Outdoor Seating Policy

Result/Next Steps

- Vote to keep current outdoor seating policy
- Change 2018 SAC Procedure Manual wording to reflect 1 SAC per 40 seats

Status

- Info item was written and approved by Task Force, and presented at Council Meeting on January 11
- Wording change will be implemented in the 2018 procedure manual



Issue 2: Evaluate Options for Manufactured Homes

Result/Next Steps

- Task Force voted unanimously to continue SAC policy for manufactured housing
- Task Force encouraged pursuit of non-MCES funded grants

 Manufactured Home Preservation Grant proceeding in 2017



Issue 3: Simplify the Determination Process

Result/Next Steps

- Task Force members asked Met Council to analyze using gross square footage as the universal criterion for determining SAC charges
- Set up future Task Force meetings in July / August to report back on analysis
