




Existing Regulators in Minneapolis – South of I-94

Status

No releases to river since 2006 (except incident in 2010)

- Joint NPDES permit authorizing wet weather releases still in effect
- EPA/MPCA plan to terminate permit



Minneapolis-Metropolitan Council Agreement

- Operations and Maintenance Responsibilities
- Inflow/Infiltration Mitigation
- Joint Study of City and Council Sewer Systems
