

Capital Program Definitions



<u>Authorized Capital Program (ACP)</u>: Multi-year authorization from Council to spend on projects where funding has been secured.

Capital Improvement Program (CIP): 6-year capital investment plan where funding sources identified. Council has not authorized to proceed.




Capital Budget: Amount from ACP that Council approves to be spent in upcoming year.







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Capital Program Expenditures Breakdown by Project Objective










