- Site 1: Bassett's Creek Park
 - 955 linear feet of 42" interceptor located in Bassett's Creek Park with cured-in-place pipe.
- Site 2: Theodore Wirth Park
 - 1525 linear feet of 36" and 1080 linear feet of 42" interceptor located in Theodore Wirth Park with cured-in-place pipe.
- Construction duration spring 2018 – fall 2018





Bid Summary

- Received five responsive, responsible bids: \$2,764,874 to \$3,703,997.50
- SAK Construction, LLC submitted the low bid, which was less than the engineer's estimate
- Disadvantaged Business Goal of 5% participation goal for this contract is 5%.
