

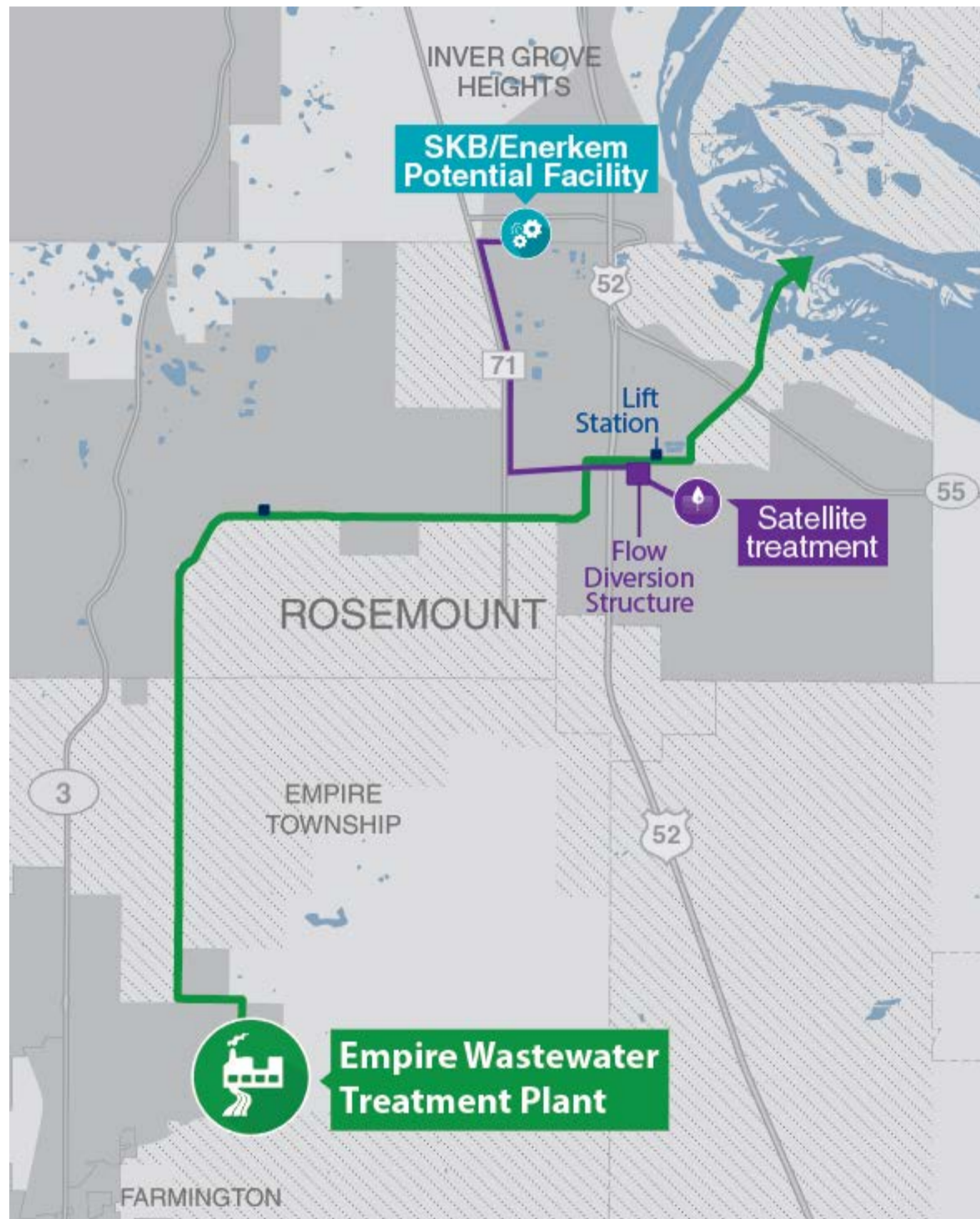

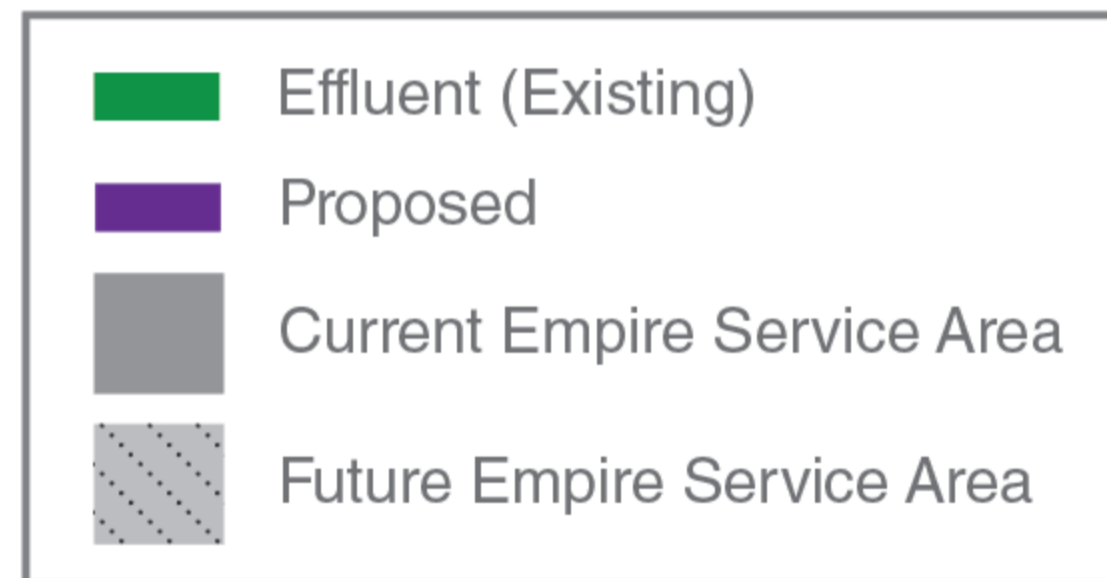


Southeast Metro Water Reclamation Facilities

Southeast Metro Water Reclamation Facilities – Proposed Schedule

Timeframe	Activity
Ongoing	Negotiate Memorandum of Understanding and Design Deposit Agreements with Enerkem
Ongoing	Pursue PFA loan funds and MPCA reuse grant
May–Aug. 2018	Facility Plan & Preliminary Design
Aug. 2018	Public Hearing on Facility Plan
Sept. 2018–Feb. 2019	Final Design
Mar.–June 2019	Construction Contract Bid and Award
July 2019–Dec. 2020	Construction & Commissioning
