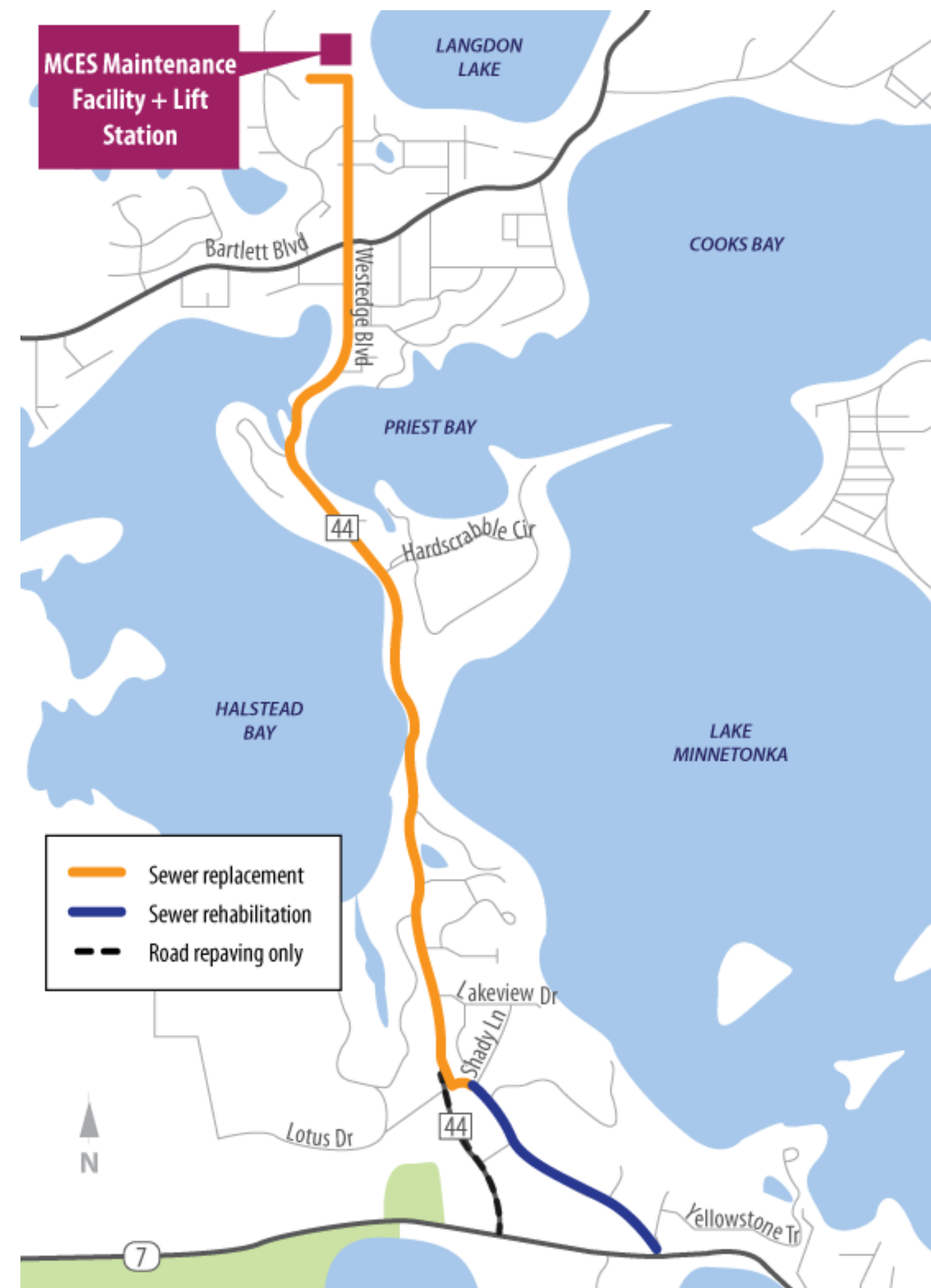

Project Overview

- MCES: Replace approximately 3 miles of existing 24" forcemain with 2-18" forcemain
- Coordination with multiple agencies
 - Mound watermain improvements
 - Hennepin County drainage and storm sewer improvements
 - Minnetrista/MCES forcemain connection improvements
 - CenterPoint Energy: Upgrade gas main
- Construction duration 2018-2020



Bid Summary

- Received three responsive, responsible bids: \$22,819,355.50 to \$27,028,401.86
- Geislinger and Sons, Inc. submitted the low bid, which was less than the engineer's estimate of \$27,610,099.00
- Disadvantaged business goals of 8% Minority Business Enterprise and 8% Women Business Enterprise

Thrive Lens Analysis
