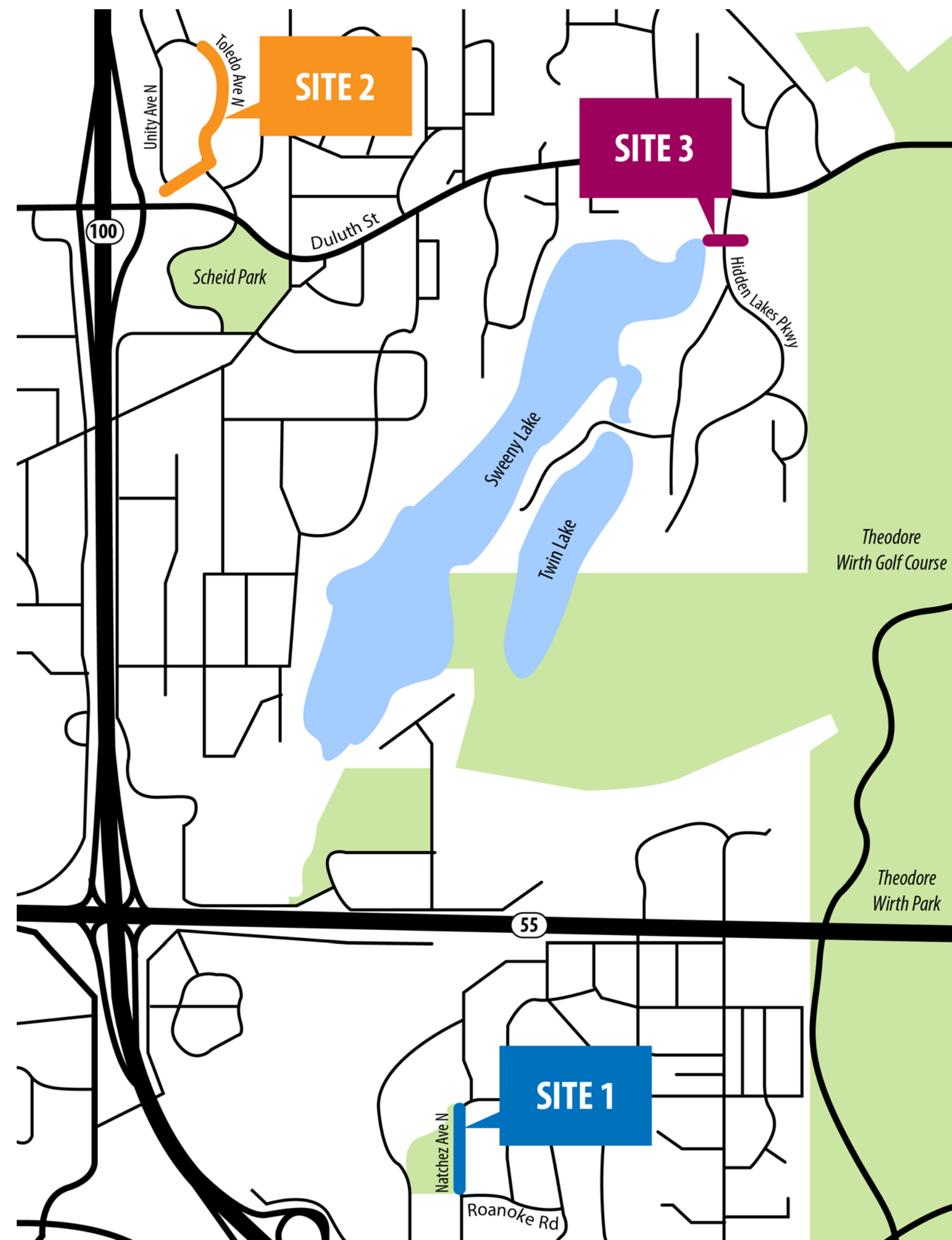

# Project Location

- Site 1: Natchez Avenue
  - 650-foot section of 36-inch interceptor near Natchez Park with cured-in-place-pipe
- Site 2: Toledo Avenue
  - 800-foot section of interceptor near Toledo Avenue and Greenview Lane of 24-inch and 30-inch open cut and 24-inch and 27-inch cured-in-place-pipe
- Site 3: Hidden Lakes Parkway
  - Approximately 120-foot section of 36-inch new pipe will be tunneled under the road parallel to the existing pipe to allow the road to remain open to traffic



# Bid Summary

- Received five responsive, responsible bids: \$4,094,731.75 to \$5,570,278.35
- Minger Construction Company, Inc. submitted the low bid, which was less than the engineer's estimate of \$4,691,384.00.
- The Metropolitan Council Under-Utilized Business (MCUB) program participation goal for this contract is 6%.
