

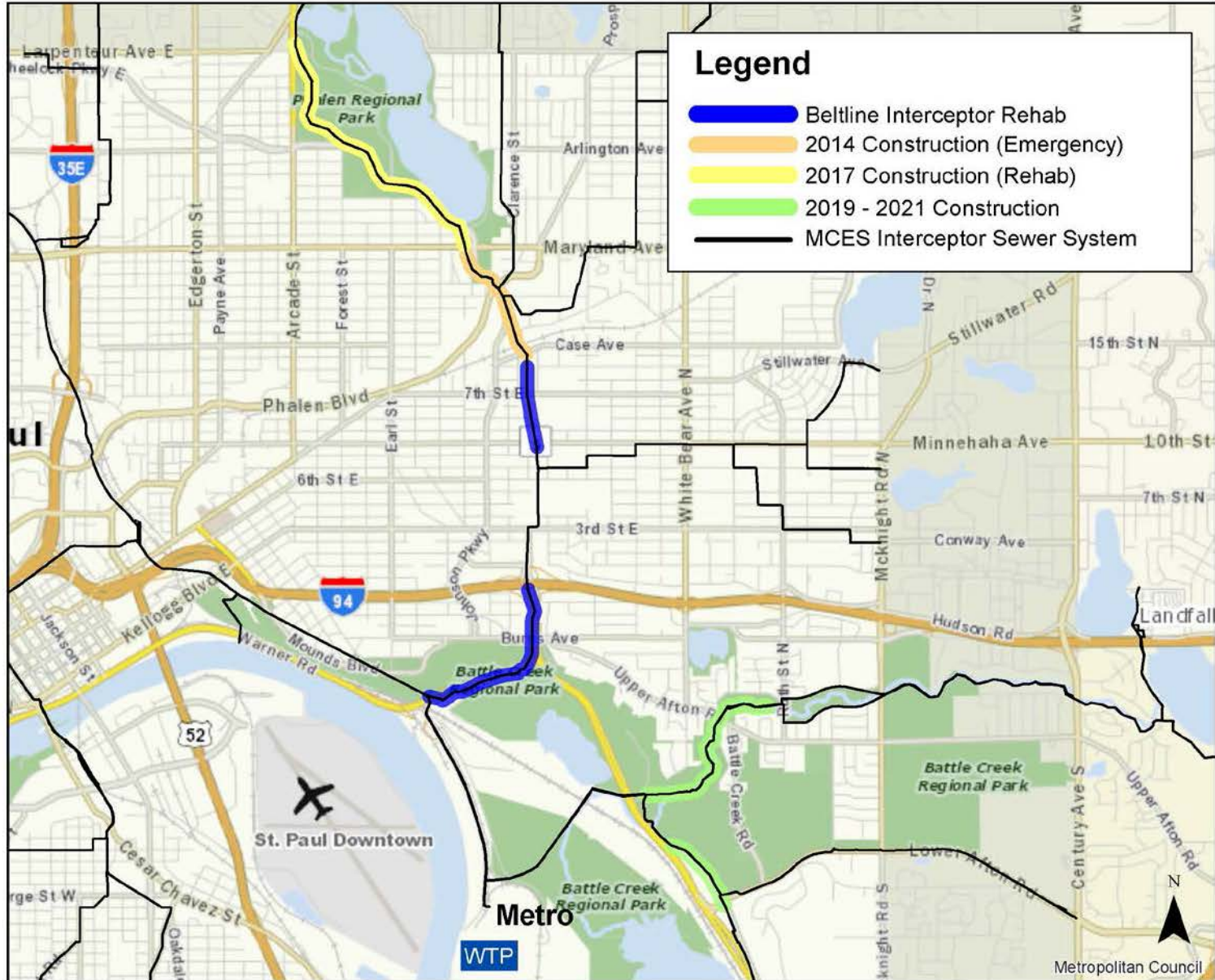

# Project Summary – Site 1



- Line 2350 LF of 54 to 60-inch diameter
- Rehabilitation of 4 access manholes
- Construction of a new manhole

# Project Summary – Site 2



- Line 4900 LF of 60 & 72-inch diameter
- Rehabilitation of 12 access manholes and associated structures

# Bid Summary

- Engineer's Estimate \$12,201,066.
- Three bids ranged from \$10,764,386.25 to \$11,618,004.50
  - Two determined to be unresponsive
- Disadvantage business participation goals
  - Minority Business Enterprise 6%
  - Women Business Enterprise 6%
- Geislinger and Sons, Inc.
  - Low responsive, responsible bid \$10,764,386.25
  - Met good faith effort towards disadvantage business participation goals



# Thrive Lens Analysis

- Stewardship - Public financial resources will be invested efficiently and effectively to maintain the existing wastewater infrastructure, which protects the region's natural resources.
