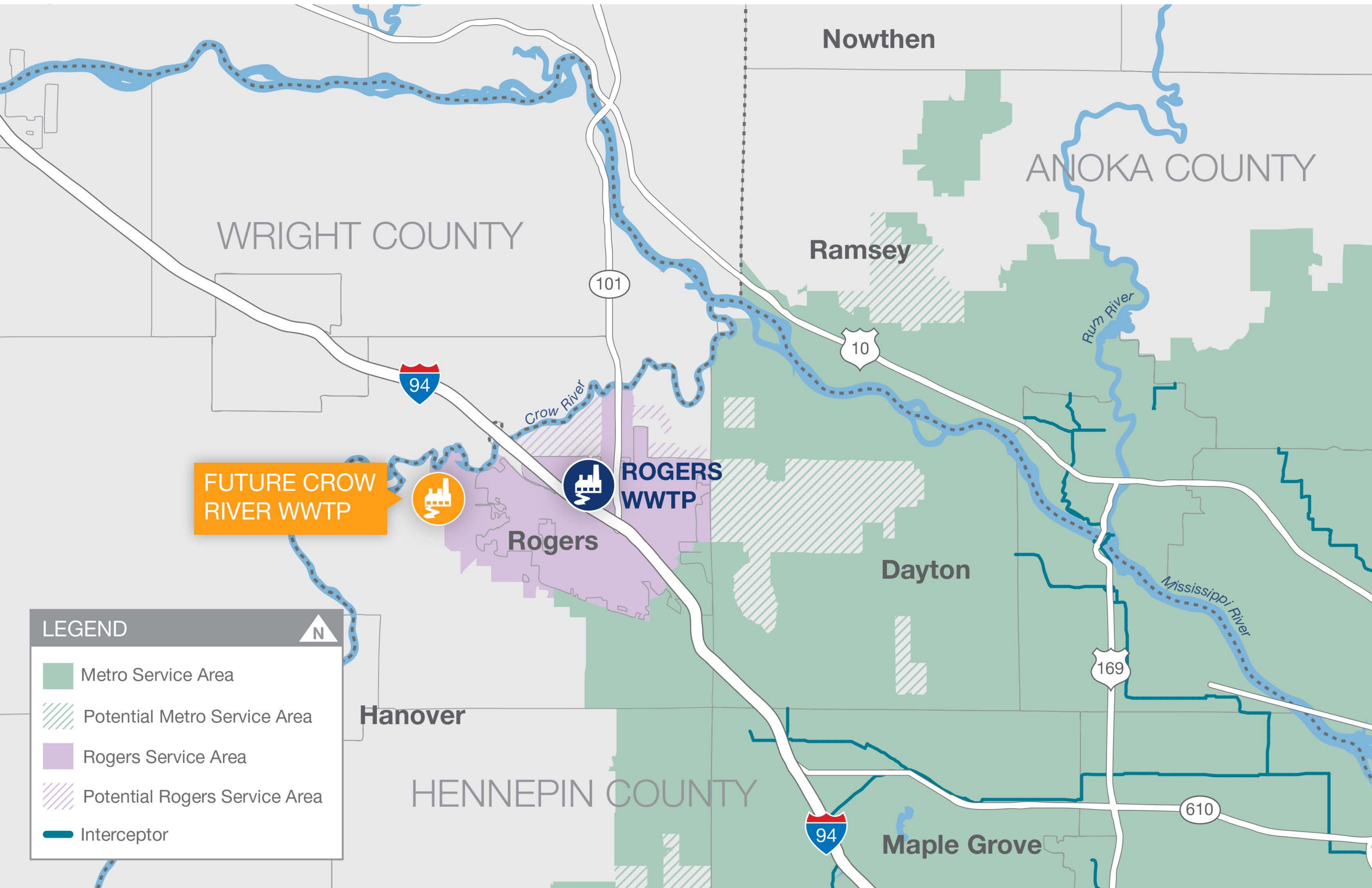
Background

Council shall *“Acquire wastewater treatment plants from suburban communities outside the current service area, based upon request through the comprehensive plan and comprehensive sewer plan process, after soliciting customer input and conducting a public hearing on the request”* (Thrive MSP 2040 Water Resources Policy Plan)

Background

- Acquisition of the Rogers WWTP was contemplated in the Rogers 2030 Comprehensive Plan (amendment approved by Council in 2016).
- Acquisition of the Rogers WWTP was contemplated in the 2040 Water Resources Policy Plan (Page 47)
- Rogers City Council formally requested acquisition of the Rogers WWTP by resolution on 10/23/18.

Rogers Wastewater Service Area



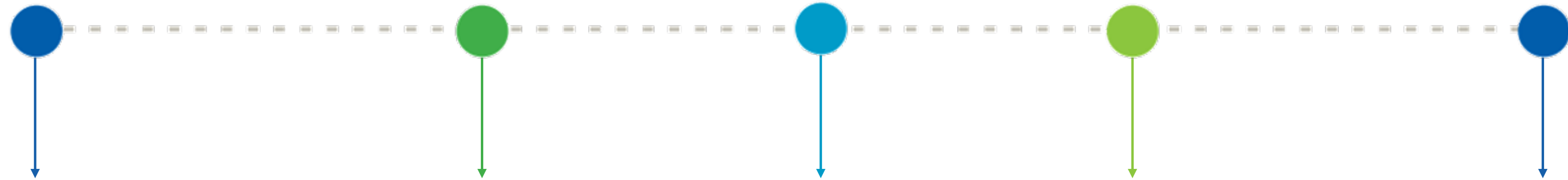
LEGEND

- Interceptor

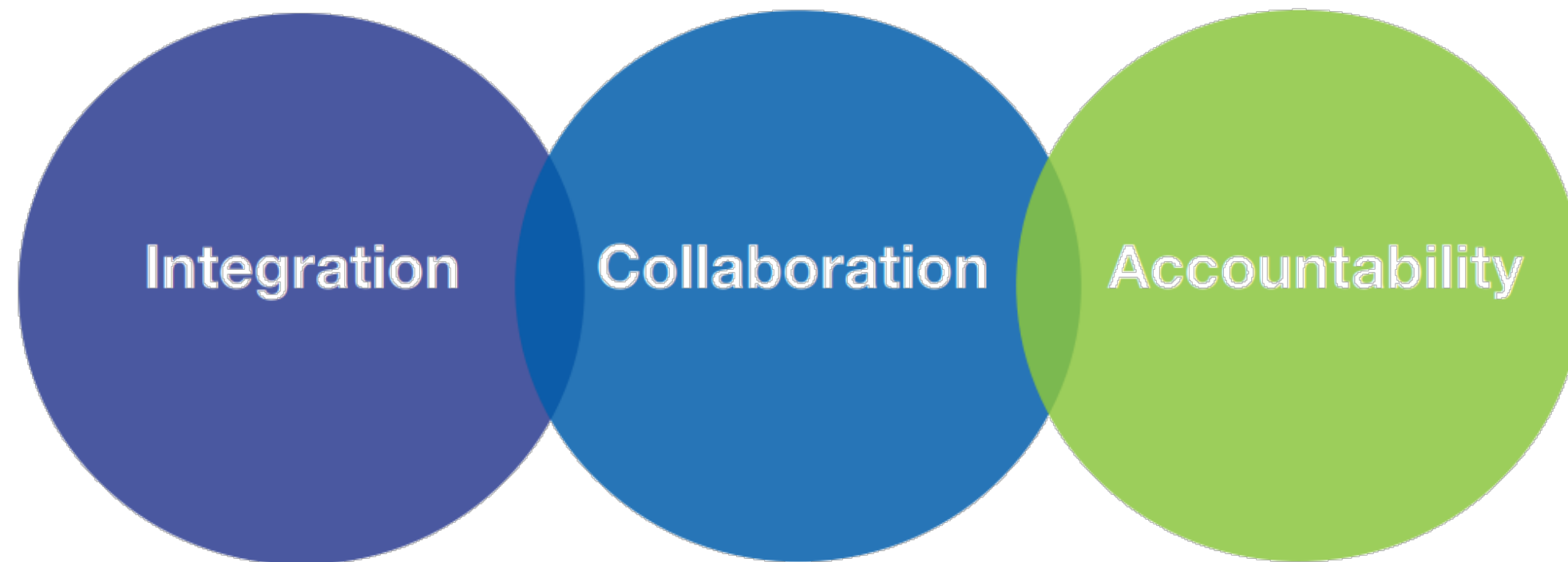
