Project Plan and Profile



Tunnel Repair Activities

- Remove loose, sloughed sandstone over the interceptor
- Repair the interceptor and interceptor service connections
- Fill the void over the interceptor with grout



Scope

- Construct Access Shafts at the intersections of 4th Street South and Hennepin Avenue & 4th Street South and Marquette Avenue
- Construct Access Tunnels from the Access Shafts to the void above Interceptor 1-MN-310
- Remove loose, sloughed sandstone over the interceptor
- Repair the interceptor and interceptor service connections
- Fill the void over the interceptor with grout

Bid Results

- Received three bids
- Bids ranged between \$3,929,674 and \$5,375,975
- PCI Roads was the low responsive, responsible bidder at \$3,929,674
- Engineer's Estimate is \$6,303,000
