

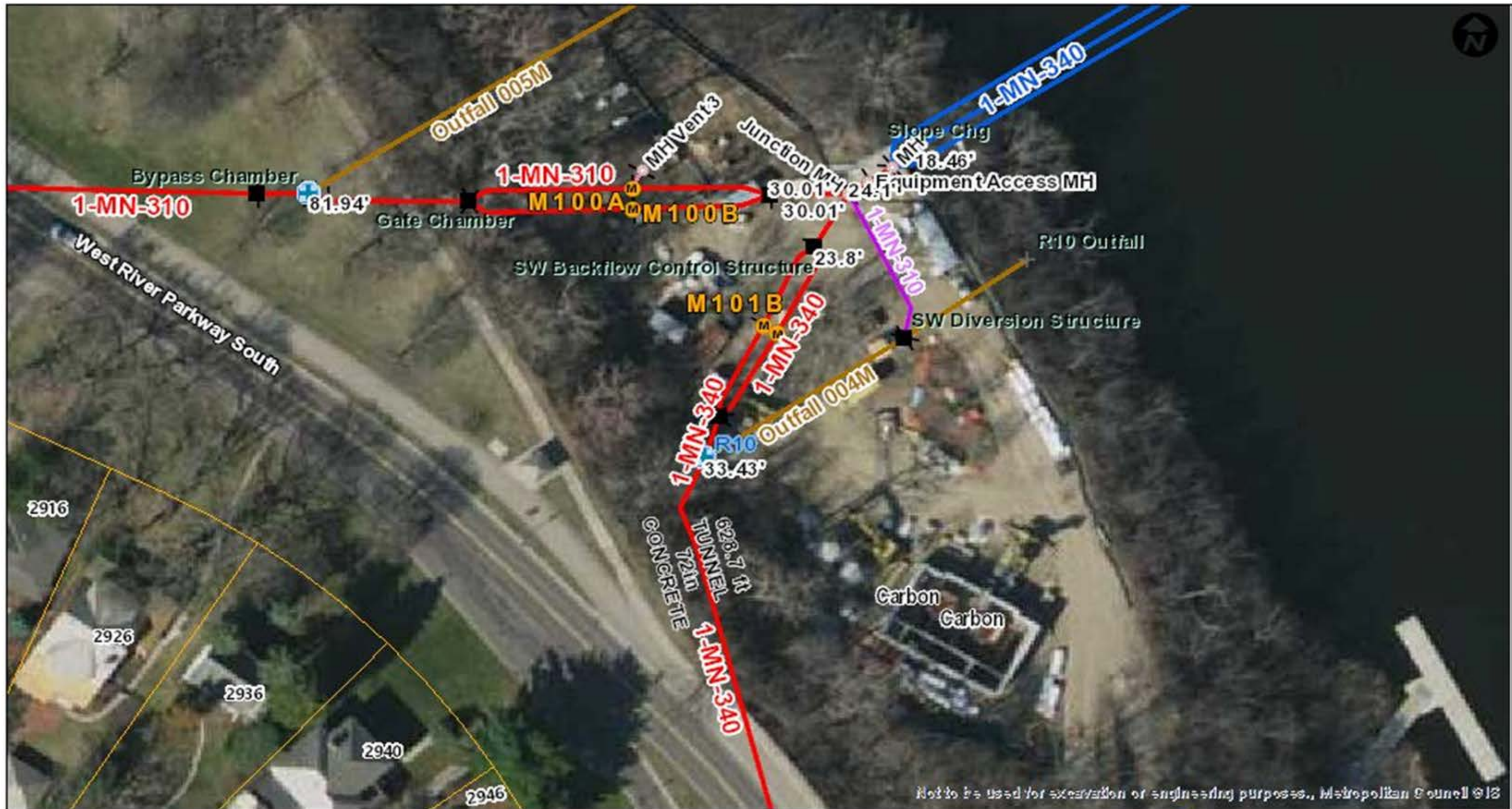

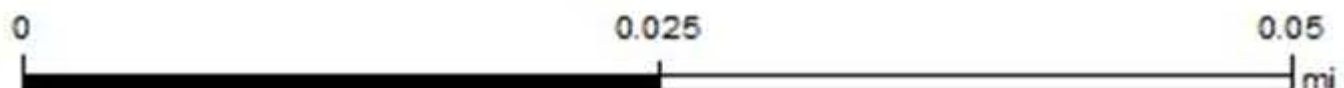


West Meters Site
