


Mahtomedi's Comprehensive Plan Update

- June 26, 2019 Metropolitan Council (Final Actions) Formally "Approval" of Wastewater Plan Advise City to Implement 2040 Plan




Community Designations – Mahtomedi Suburban

Inflow and Infiltration Mitigation Efforts

- Mahtomedi has been identified as a contributor of excess Inflow and Infiltration (I/I).
- No assigned work plans since 2014.
- Applied for and received \$65,404 in State Bond I/I Grants in 2017.
- Plan includes defined goals, policies, and strategies for I/I reduction in both the public and private property portions of the local system.
- Existing Ordinance that requires "disconnection" of foundation drains, sump pumps and rain leaders.
- Developing implementation plan for preventing and eliminating excessive I/I from entering both the public and private sewer systems. Focuses efforts on the private system in the area of service wye connections.



Comprehensive Sewer Plan Findings

- Conforms with the Regional Wastewater System Plan
- Consistent with other Council adopted plans and policies
- Satisfies all the required plan elements
- Regional Wastewater System with its scheduled improvements has sufficient capacity to serve the City's projected growth as stated in the Plan
