




Community Designations – Victoria Emerging Suburban Edge



Inflow and Infiltration Mitigation Efforts

- Victoria has NOT been identified as a contributor of excess Inflow and Infiltration (I/I).
- Victoria's total wastewater flow discharge is estimated. No method to determine peak flow discharges.
- Plan includes defined goals, policies, and strategies for I/I reduction in both the public and private property portions of the local system.
- Ordinance that requires "disconnection" of foundation drains, sump pumps and rain leaders upon discovery.
- Requires all new development to install behind-the-curb sump pump connection services to storm sewer system.
- Implementation plan includes a public education program to educate and assist private property owners to identify issues with their private services.





Comprehensive Sewer Plan Findings

- Conforms with the Regional Wastewater System Plan
- Consistent with other Council adopted plans and policies
- Satisfies all the required plan elements
- Regional Wastewater System with its scheduled improvements has sufficient capacity to serve the City's projected growth as stated in the Plan

<u>Advisories</u>

A copy of the City Council resolution adopting its 2040 Plan, including its Comprehensive Sewer Plan, must be submitted to the Council.
