


Orono's Comprehensive Plan Update






Community Designations

Inflow and Infiltration Mitigation Efforts

- Orono has been identified as a contributor of excess Inflow and Infiltration (I/I).
- \$553,000 in work plan assignments between 2011 and 2017.
- Applied for and awarded \$131,283 in State Bond I/I Grants.
- Plan includes defined goals, policies, and strategies for I/I reduction in both the public and private property portions of the local system.
- Existing Ordinance that requires "disconnection" of foundation drains, sump pumps and rain leaders.
- Developing implementation plan for preventing and eliminating excessive I/I from entering both the public and private sewer systems.



Comprehensive Sewer Plan Findings

- Conforms with the Regional Wastewater System Plan
- Consistent with other Council adopted plans and policies
- Satisfies all the required plan elements
- Regional Wastewater System with its scheduled improvements has sufficient capacity to serve the City's projected growth as stated in the Plan

Wastewater Plan Advisories

A copy of the City Council resolution adopting its Plan, including the Comprehensive Sewer Plan component, must be submitted to the Council.
