

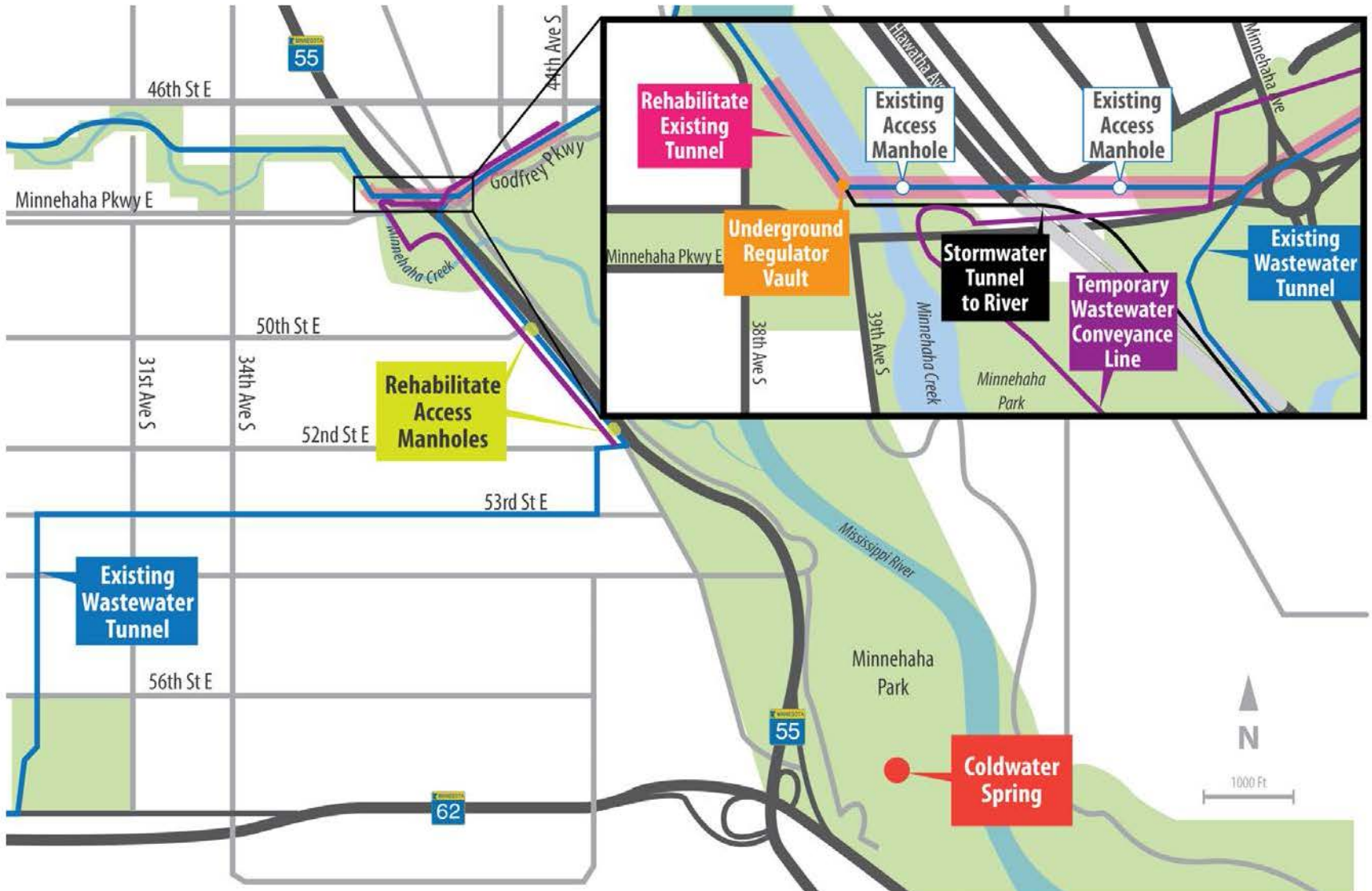

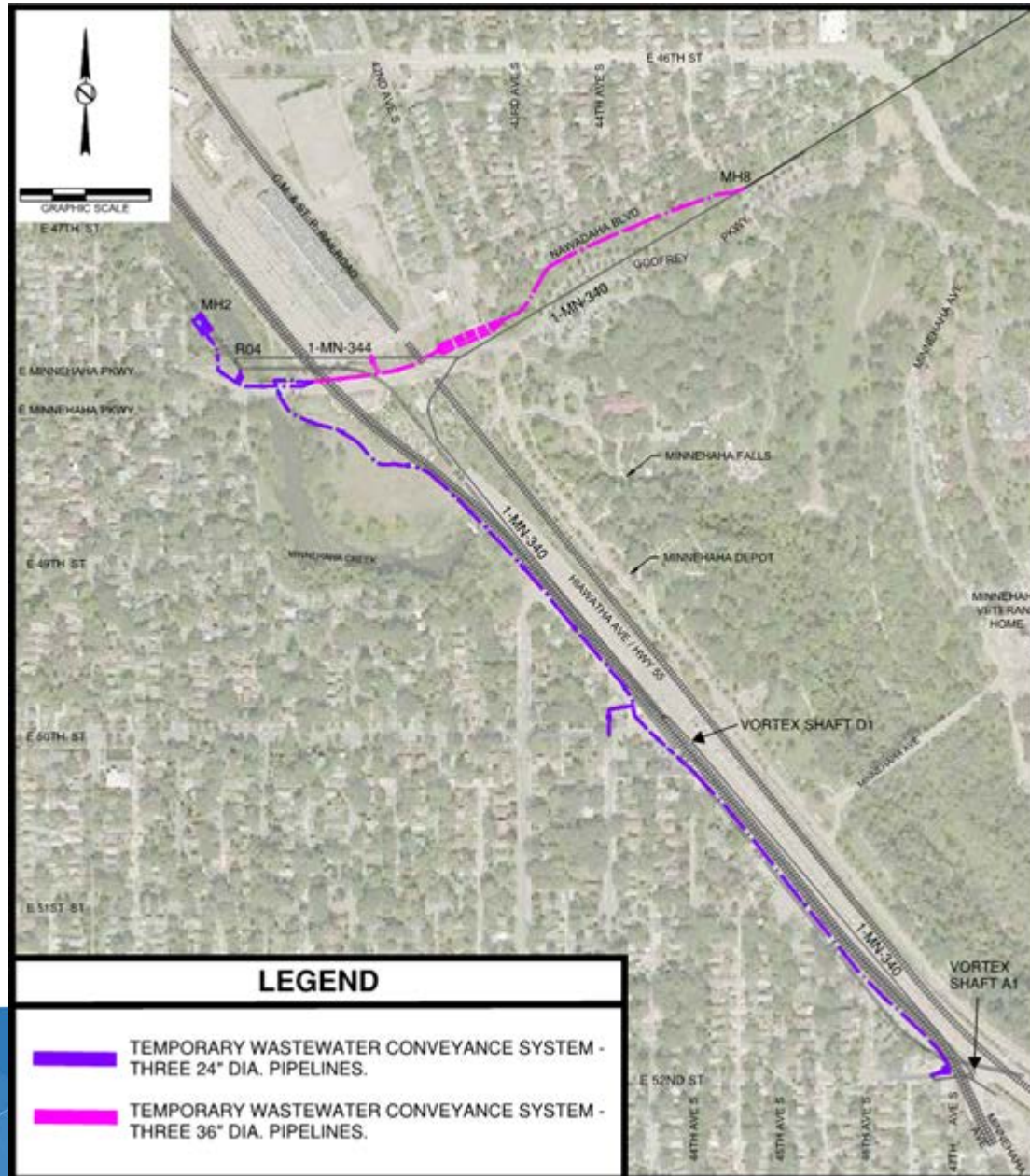

- 24 hour security monitoring planned
- Northern temporary conveyance (magenta): 2-year duration
- Southern temporary conveyance (purple): 1-year duration
