

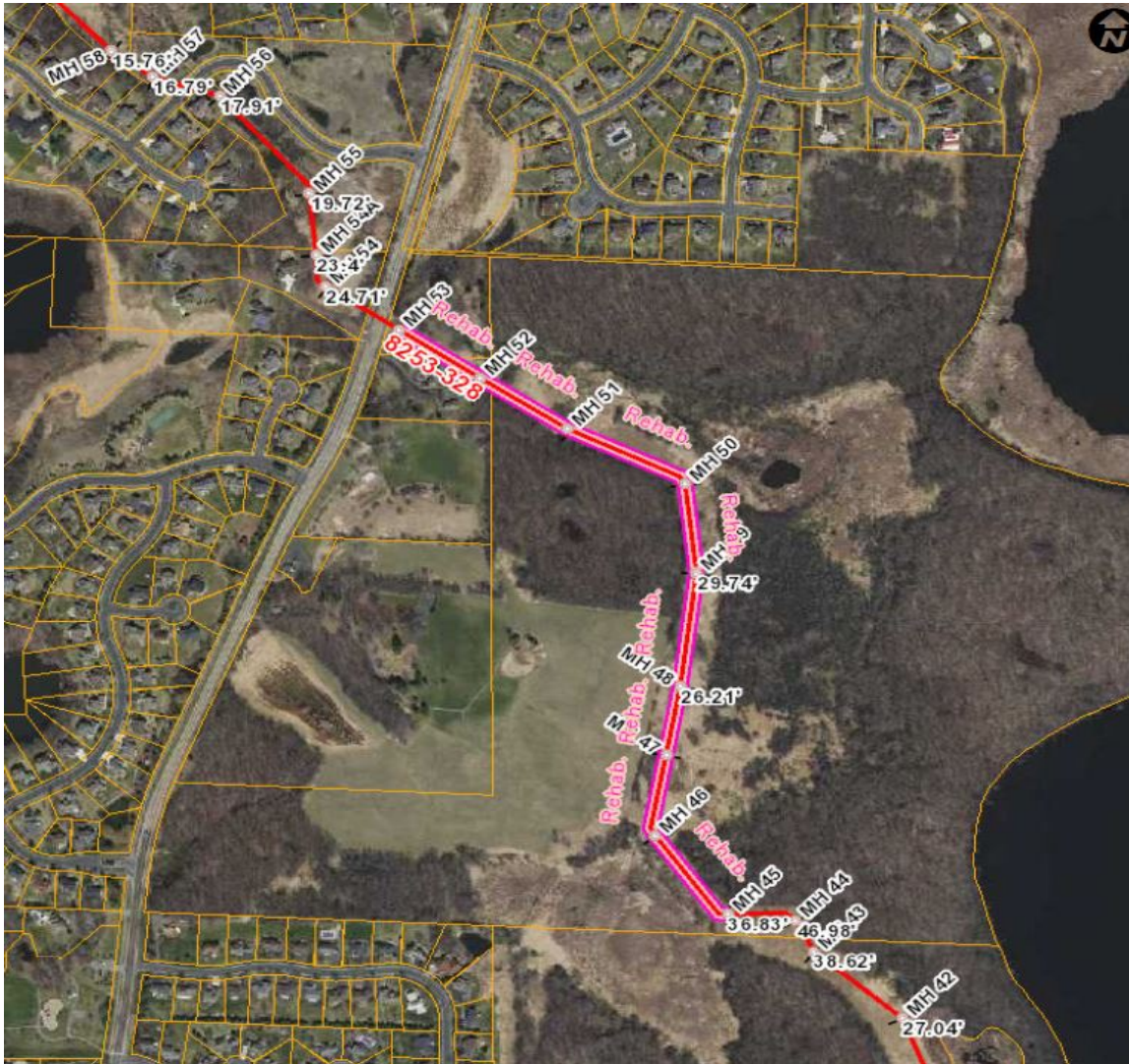
Business Item 2019-326: Chanhassen Interceptor Rehabilitation 8253-328

Project Summary



- 2800 feet of existing concrete gravity sewer has significant corrosion
- The property around the MCES pipe is currently being developed into single family homes
- Cooperative construction agreement with the City of Chanhasseen to line 1000 feet of City sewer

Bid Summary

- Engineer's Estimate \$4,434,980.00
- Four bids received ranged from \$3,690,537.25 to \$4,524,992.60
- Lowest bid received from Visu-Sewer, Inc.
