

Business Item 2019-327: Master Contract for Geotechnical Engineering and Testing Services

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Environment Committee: November 12, 2019



Need

- Authorized Capital Program (ACP) for the capital program work is approximately \$980 million. This translates into approximately \$600,000 in annual geotechnical services to support capital improvements.
- The proposed \$2 million master contract provides the contract capacity needed for design and construction materials testing to support interceptor improvements.

Contract Scope

- Geotechnical services
 - Geotechnical Investigations
 - Hydrological Investigations
 - Vibration Monitoring
 - Geotechnical Modeling
 - Construction Materials Testing

Proposal Summary

- Five proposals were received and evaluated
- Request for Proposal anticipated one contract with a total value of \$2 million
- Recommended award and contract value:
 - American Engineering and Testing: \$2,000,000
- Firm was the highest ranked and demonstrated the best directly related expertise and experience

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute master contract 19P033 with American Engineering and Testing for a not to exceed amount of \$2,000,000.
