

Business Item 2019-278: Brooklyn Park and Champlin Interceptor Renewal Phase 1, Part 2

Project Summary

- Site on Mississippi Lane includes replacing existing 60-inch pipe with 72-inch pipe.
- Site on Riverview Lane includes Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) lining of 60-inch and 66-inch pipe.
- Manholes on both sites will be replaced with new manholes.
- Both sites will include removing the direct local connections from the interceptor and connecting to a new local sewer pipe, which will be then connected to the interceptor through a lift station.
- Local sewer pipe and a bigger City lift station will be installed on this project. The City will take ownership of the local system at the end of the construction work.

Trail and Park Impacts



West River Road Trail

- Temporary conveyance pipe will be set up on the West River Road Trail
- Trail will be closed for the duration of up to 18 months between Winter 2019-2020 to mid summer 2021



Jewel Park

- Project Pumping Station and equipment will be staged at Jewel Park
- Playground, park building, and parking lot will remain open to public
