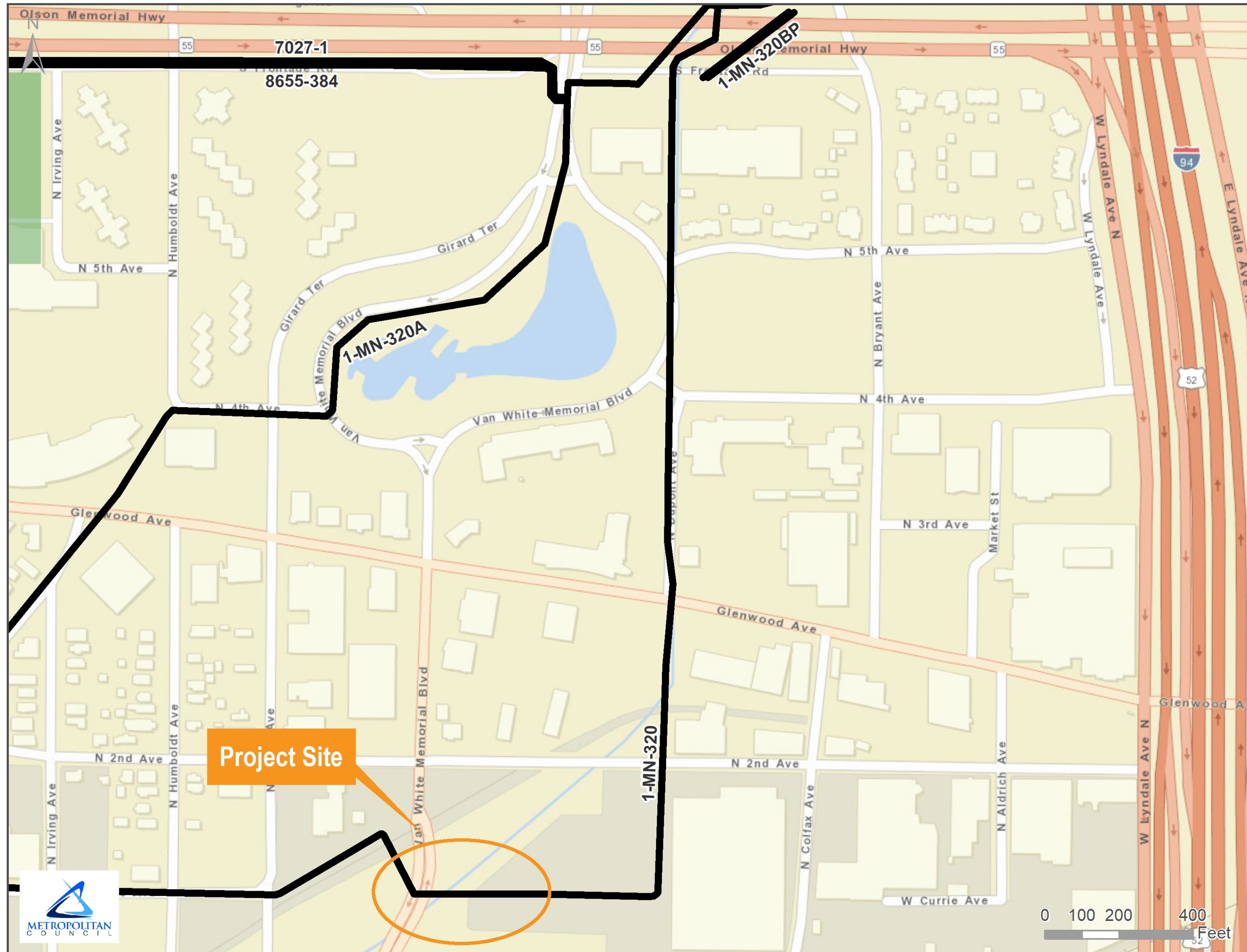

# Emergency Declaration Process

- Infrastructure concern identified and investigated
- Determination made that carrying out the competitive bidding process prescribed by the Council's Procurement Policy would unacceptably delay the commencement of work to repair the facility
- Emergency Declaration Document is prepared and signed by the General Manager, Environmental Services
- After review, the Emergency Declaration is authorized by the Regional Administrator, who has delegated authority pursuant to the Council's Procurement Policy.
- Contractor is selected and work begins under the direction of a Council Authorized Representative
- Emergency Declaration is ratified by Metropolitan Council, if the cost to correct the emergency exceeds \$100,000

# Scope and Estimate

- Engineering services to support repair work
- Repair of 1-MN-320 through open-cut excavation
- Traffic control
- Temporary wastewater conveyance
- Surface restoration
- Project communications
- Total estimated cost is approximately \$1 million
