

Background

- Evoqua is current vendor
- Evoqua installed and owns chemical storage tanks and delivery systems
- Business Case Evaluation recommended that MCES procure equipment and competitively bid chemical and professional services
- On January 31, 2020, Procurement approved a 3-month extension to the PO until April 30, 2020

Proposed Action

- That the Metropolitan Council authorizes award, negotiation, and execution of sole source contract with Evoqua Water Technologies Inc. not to exceed \$2,600,000 to provide bulk chemicals and services for odor and corrosion control
- Execute a sole source contract for approximately 12 months to allow time to purchase storage tanks and delivery systems (pumps, piping, and controls) and to develop a competitive solicitation
