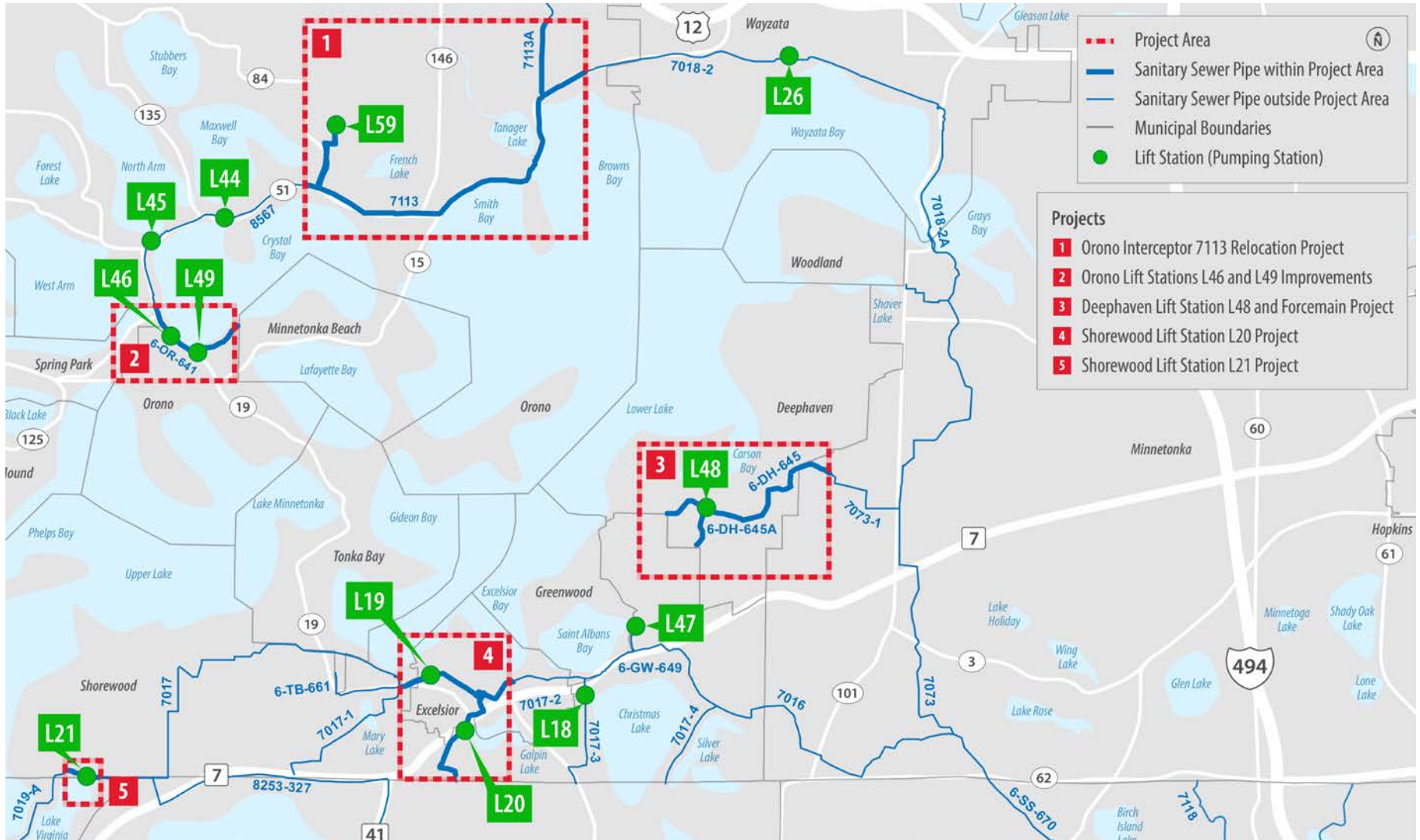

Improvements Required

- Hydraulic modeling, flow projections, condition assessments, age of infrastructure, and cooperative opportunities used to identify five projects
- Project Types:
 - ✓ Rehabilitation: Lift Stations L46, L21, and L48
 - ✓ Replacement of infrastructure: L20 (new pipe through Excelsior), L49, and Interceptor 6-DH-645
 - ✓ Realignment: Forcemain 7113 (will be relocating out of CSAH 15)

Next Steps

- October 6 and 8, 2020: Draft Facility Plan Open House (virtual)
- December 15, 2020: Public Hearing (virtual)
- January 27, 2021: Council considers comments and Adopts Facility Plan
- February 26, 2021: Submittal to Public Facilities Authority and MPCA for inclusion in the Intended Use Plan
