Scope of Work

- Expand & improve the substation
- Replace electrical distribution equipment that is near end of service life
- Reroute power conductors to simplify power distribution from two hubs to one hub
- Expand Wi-Fi network



Bid Results

- Invitation for bid (IFB) was advertised on April 28, 2021
- Procurement facilitated a public bid opening on July 29, 2021
- Two bids were received
- Total Construction & Equipment, Inc. bid was in the amount of \$47,100,000
- This project is financed by a loan from the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority and has a disadvantaged business participation goal of 4%
- The Office of Equal Opportunity determined that Total Construction & Equipment has met the DBE requirements
