

Improvements Required

- Hydraulic modeling, flow projections, condition assessments, age of infrastructure, and cooperative opportunities used to identify five projects
- Projects Types Identified
 - Rehabilitation: Lift Stations L46, L21, and L48
 - Replacement of infrastructure: Lift Stations L20 (new pipe through Excelsior), L49, and Interceptor 6-DH-645
 - Realignment: Forcemain 7113 move out CSAH 15
- Funding for design and construction has been included in the 2020 Capital Program

5. Shorewood Lift Station L21 Project	\$5,510,000
