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

Bid Summary

- Two Bids Received on April 27, 2021
 - First bid, Total Mechanical was \$15,665,585.70
 - Second bid, Rice Lake Construction Group was \$15,802,000
- Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal 9%
 - Office of Equal Opportunity (OEO) determined that the DBE requirements for this contract have been met.
 - Total Mechanical is the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Proposed Action
