Project Drivers

- Existing 50-year-old lift station has reached the end of its useful life.
 - Condition assessments have documented structural, mechanical, and electrical deficiencies which have led to system failures.
 - Backups and odor issues
- The lift station is almost at its full pumping capacity and requires expansion to meet the current and future needs of the area.
- Existing site (west of Mississippi River) is too small for the new lift station.
- MCES owns a property east of the Mississippi River with adequate space for the future lift station.
