

Project Summary

- The Capital Improvement Program anticipated the expansion and rehabilitation of the Regional Maintenance Facility (RMF) in Eagan. RMF currently provides space for staff from Interceptor Engineering, Interceptor Services Business Unit, and Maintenance. The expansion will provide space for Air Quality staff, the odor laboratory, and Construction Services staff to be relocated to RMF, and will address other deficiencies in the existing building.
- Eagan, Minnesota Code of Ordinances Chapter 13, Sec. 13.01 and Sec. 13.02, Subd. 1, describe the purpose for platting the property and the jurisdiction requirements. The MCES property that includes RMF must be platted and approved by the City Council of Eagan before a building permit will be granted.
