Project Background

- L48 and Forcemain 6-DH-645 are reaching the end of their service life
- The 10-inch forcemain will be replaced via directional drilling
- 1,000 feet of gravity discharge pipe will be replaced via open cut construction
- Temporary easement rights are necessary to accommodate temporary conveyance piping, construction staging and access

- MCES Project 802834
- MCES Interceptor
- Approximate Temporary Easement

Proposed Temporary Easements

Temporary easements are required for 4 properties including residential and public land.

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council passes Resolution 2022-9 authorizing the acquisition of temporary easements for the L48 Rehabilitation and Forcemain 6-DH-645 Replacement project and staff to initiate condemnation proceedings.
