

Environmental Services Project Summary

- Install dual 24" plastic forcemains within the right-of-way in Humboldt Avenue
- Replace the vortex drop pipe and structure which discharges MCES forcemain into Interceptor 1-MN-330
- Upgrade city storm sewer to reduce the risk of flooding at the low point on Humboldt Avenue (City-funded)

Project Area



CenterPoint Energy Work

- Relocate 1,500 lineal feet of gas main in conflict with new Metropolitan Council dual 24" pressure pipes
- Reconnect all resident gas service pipes to new gas main
- CenterPoint Energy started the relocation work without an executed contract
- An invoice was received from CenterPoint Energy and reviewed to be complete and within the expected costs for the work
- The cost to relocate the CenterPoint gas main was planned and budgeted under project 804136 (Hopkins System Improvements, Cooperative Agreements)

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council ratifies the After-the-Fact Purchase Order #21012387 in the amount of \$544,533.35 to CenterPoint Energy for relocation of gas main.
