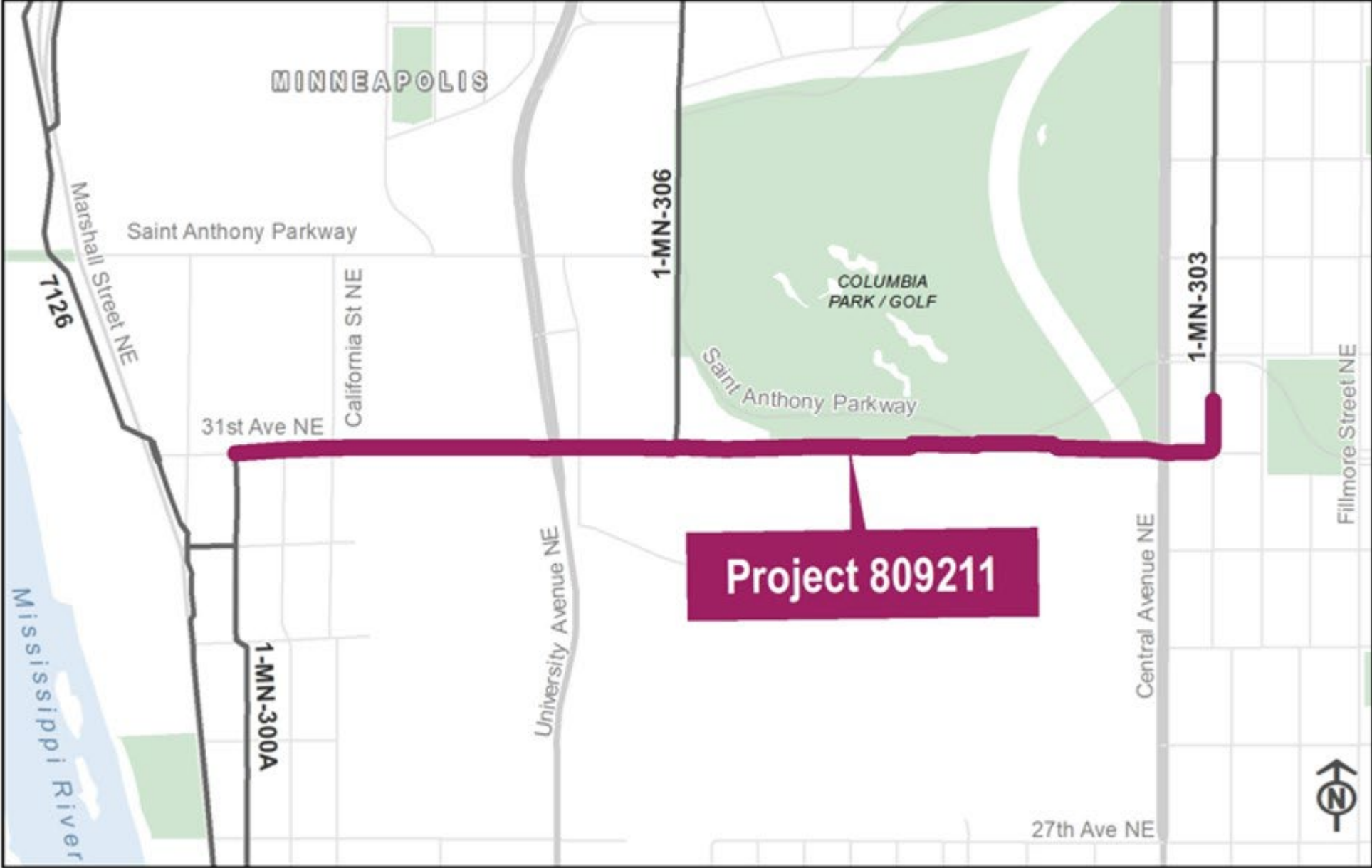

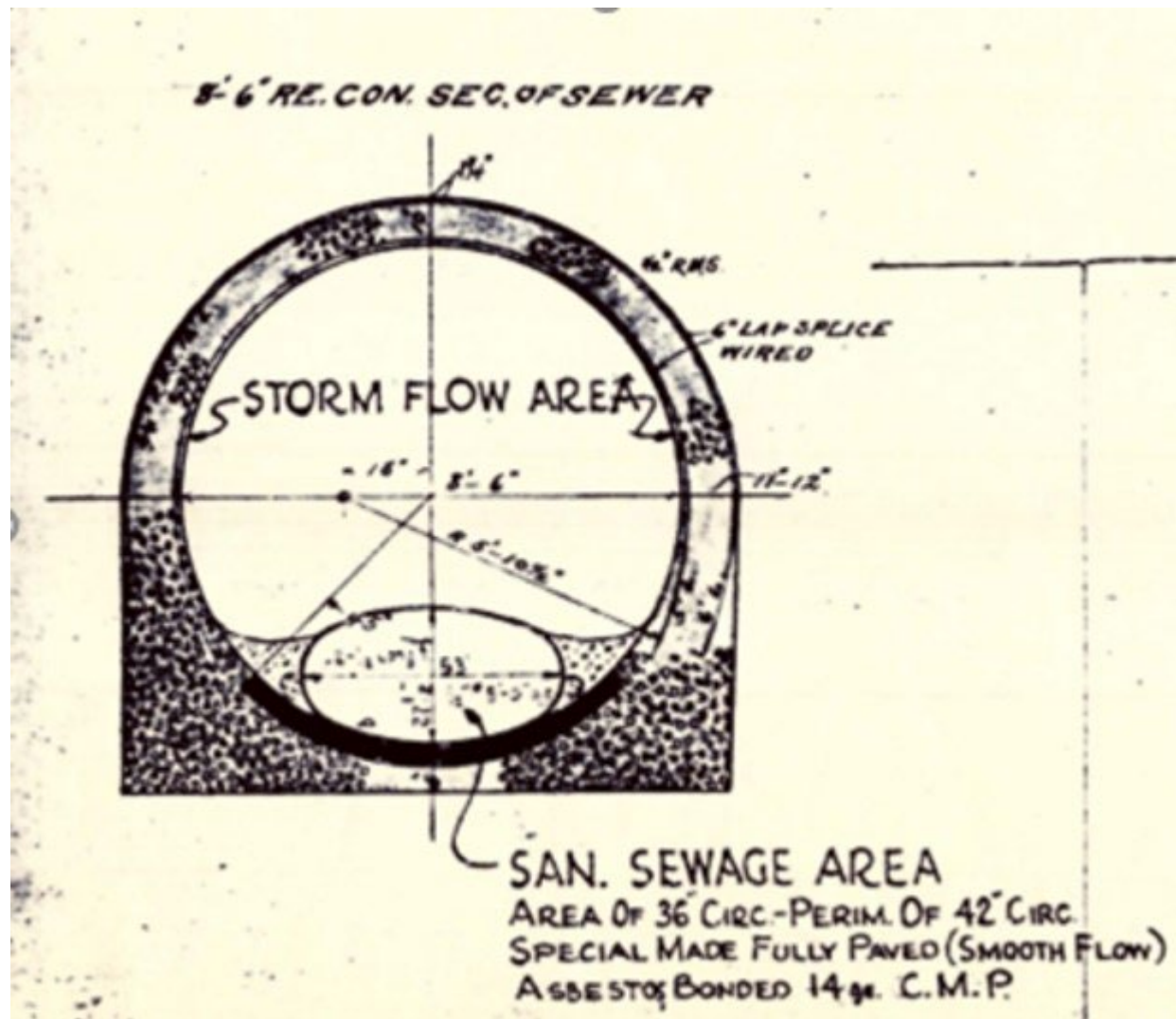

Project Background



Interceptor 1-MN-303:

- Built in 1920s as a 102" combined sanitary/storm sewer.
- Converted to a “pipe-in-pipe” (PIP) separated sewer in 1965.
- PIP is deteriorated and may be under capacity
- Evaluation underway to determine if repair or replacement with a larger pipe is required.
- Land acquisition necessary to repair or replace the PIP.
- Stakeholders include the Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board, Minneapolis Utilities, and two railroads

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council pass Resolution 2022-10 authorizing acquisition of temporary and permanent easements for Interceptor 1-MN-303 Rehabilitation Project 809211 and staff to initiate condemnation proceedings.
