Criteria

- Quality of the proposal
- Qualifications of the proposer
- Experience of the proposer
- Price of the proposal

Consensus

- The evaluation panel found that the proposal by Inductive Automation is the most advantageous to the Council.

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to award and execute contract 22P273 with Inductive Automation, Inc. to provide Human Machine Interface (HMI) software, training, and support services in an amount not to exceed \$1,106,050.
