
Authorization to Hold Public Hearing on Draft Facility Plan for the Forest Lake Interceptor 7029 Rehabilitation, Project Number 808603

Improvements Required

Condition assessment of this interceptor determined the need for a project based on the overall poor condition of the existing 36" reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) originally constructed in 1971. A condition assessment was performed on this pipe in 2018 and found to be in poor condition (rating 4). Three areas of improvements are proposed for the project which include cleaning the existing interceptor, rehabilitation through trenchless methods, and replacement or rehabilitation of the existing structures.

Next Steps

Tentative dates for the facility plan public hearing process (subject to change):

- September 25, 2024: Authorization granted from Metropolitan Council to hold public hearing
- November 10, 2024 (or later): Public Hearing (virtual)
- January 8, 2025: Metropolitan Council considers comments and adopts final Facility Plan
- February 2025: Submittal to Public Facilities Authority and MPCA for inclusion in the Intended Use Plan

That the Metropolitan Council authorize a public hearing to gather input on the draft Facility Plan for the Forest Lake Interceptor 7029 Rehabilitation, Project Number 808603.
