Interceptor 1-MN-346 Rehabilitation – Phase 2, Agreement to Relocate Natural Gas Pipeline (Contract No. 24P234)

Project Area

29th Avenue South from 53rd to 56th Street East, Minneapolis



Project Scope

1-MN-346 Rehabilitation Phase 2

- Remove/replace 2,000 feet of 54-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe to correct severe sagging and provide future capacity.
- Remove and replace 2 “air jumpers” to improve air flow and prevent build up of potentially hazardous gasses in the pipe.
- Reroute 62 residential sanitary service connections from the interceptor to a City lift station.
- Remove and replace existing utilities as needed to install the new pipe, including a CenterPoint Energy natural gas line.

Proposed Action

1-MN-346 Rehabilitation Phase 2

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to enter into an agreement with CenterPoint Energy to relocate a natural gas line for the purposes of constructing Project 809207 1-MN-346 Rehabilitation Phase 2 for an amount not to exceed \$600,000.
