Project Background

Facility Planning was completed this past March for the 7029 Interceptor after a condition assessment revealed the pipe in poor condition. The interceptor is a 36" reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) originally constructed in 1971. Design is currently being finalized to line the interceptor with Cured-in-Place-Pipe (CIPP). To complete the rehabilitation, the Council will need to obtain temporary easements adjacent to 10 private property parcels for construction access and working space.
