Background

Last month, leadership from the Council's three divisions provided an overview of the process for developing the 2050 Regional Development Guide and the four regional policy plans (Water Resources, Parks, Transportation, and Housing). At the April 19th meeting of the EAC, we would like to facilitate a discussion of the Values, Vision, and Goals that will establish the foundation for the planning and policy work to follow.

In various early conversations with staff and Councilmembers around this work, we recognize that the words we use matter a great deal. They can help set a constructive tone, provide clarity of purpose to our work, and inspire action. Furthermore, they can also establish a chain of accountability so that our policies and strategies are developed (or adjusted) in service of the overall Vision.
