Topics for meeting on March 20

- Transportation and land use strategies for updating the Transportation Policy Plan (TPP)
- Transit market areas for the TPP

Ideas to aid discussion of topics in work plan

- Industry clusters
 - o Industry clusters are geographic concentrations of businesses that sell goods or services outside of the region and help define its economic competitiveness.
- Racially concentrated areas of poverty (RCAPs) and land use role, including access to opportunities for RCAPs
- Revised population, household and employment forecasts for communities, following planned adoption of *Thrive MSP 2040 (Thrive*) in April 2014
- Local Planning Handbook and technical assistance for Thrive
 - The Local Planning Handbook and technical assistance are provided by the Council to guide and support local municipalities in developing and amending their comprehensive plans.
- Typologies for transit station areas maybe in 2015
 - Typologies will set expectations for transit-supportive land use planning, such as connectivity, density and intensity.
