

- Every five to seven years the Metropolitan Council since 1984 (and previously)




















### More acres of developed land... but growing more slowly






### Residential construction is driving land development

All Developed Land, 2016




Land Use Changes, 2010-2016



Other developed uses




#### The greening of the region: Growth in parks and recreation






### Preserving opportunities for agriculture in the region



Average annual acreage of agricultural land lost




#### Land Supply: Where does new development occur?
