# Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) Update

- Last plan update adopted January, 2015
- Federal required update every 4 years
- Moved schedule up slightly to maximize flexibility for new Council
- Update adoption targeted for mid-2018

### **Performance Based Planning**

- Federal law requires MPOs to tie the selection of transportation investments to outcomes and measure progress towards meeting the desired outcomes (performance-based planning)
- Current plan sets Transportation System Goals,
   Objectives, Strategies
- A key component of performance based planning is identifying the important measures that will help the region select investments
- Selected performance measures and targets included in plan update
- Ability to describe impact of the plan

#### **Federal Performance Measures**

- Measures cover several areas:
  - Safety
  - Transit State of Good Repair
  - Pavement Condition
  - Bridge Condition
  - System Performance
  - Freight
  - CMAQ
- Rely on observed data, assess "current" condition

#### **TPP Performance Measures**


- Broad Categories
  - Asset Management and Condition
  - Travel Time and Reliability
  - Safety
  - Mode Balance
  - Accessibility
  - Economy
  - Health
- Forecastable, assess future conditions

#### **LUAC** Involvement

- Presented to Committee on July 20, 2017
- Ask for suggested refinements to proposed performance measures
- Give input on additional performance measures:
  - Responsive to investments and strategies in TPP
  - Tied to a goal or objective of the TPP

## TPP Performance Measures Land Use Related

- Number of Jobs Accessible in 30 Minutes by Mode
- Population with Access to High-Frequency Transit Service
- Acres of Riverfront Industrial Land
- Acres of Rail-Accessible Industrial Land
- Job and Population Growth Near High-Frequency Transit Service
- Transit Supportive Comprehensive Plans
