


Guides growth in seven-county metropolitan area & provides regional services


Regional system plans

Matters of metropolitan significance as requested by the Council



Committee meetings and Open Meeting Law

Public notice of meetings & meetings must be open to the public

Open Meeting Law requirements apply

Remote access to meetings?

Must meet Open Meeting Law requirements

Other meetings or communications

- Social gatherings
- Serial or chain communications



More on Committee meetings

Order of business

 Approve agenda, approve minutes, consider business items, consider other business including information items or reports, and adjourn meeting.

Conduct of business

Roberts Rules of Order

Attendance

- Attendance for productive meetings and representation
- If absence unavoidable, notify Committee Secretary in advance



Committee Bylaws on conflicts of interest

Committee Bylaws, Article III, E. Conflicts of Interest

- Participation in discussion or a vote
- Appearance of a conflict of interest



Transit, parking and reimbursement

- Meetings accessible by transit
- Parking in two nearby ramps
 - Parking vouchers
- Reimbursement
 - Mileage
 - On-street parking
